- 3 Four-oared dug-out. Course, round Island. 1st prize, \$20; 2nd, \$10. Three canoes to enter or no race.



DEFINITION OF AN AMATEUR, AS ADOPTED BY THE CANADIAN ASSOCIATION OF AMATEUR OARSMEN.

One who has not entered in an open competition, or for either a stake, public or admission money, or entrance fee, or competed with or against a professional for any prize since January 1st. 1876; who has never taught, pursued or assisted in the pursuit of athletic exercise as a means of livelihood; whose membership of any rowing or other athletic club was not brought about, or does not continue, because of any mutual agreement or understanding, expressed or implied, whereby, his becoming or continuing a member of such a club would be of any pecuniary benefit to him whatever, direct or indirect, and who has never been employed in any occupation involving any use of the oar or paddle.
