Plumbers Drew From Hat To Decide as to Tender

Would Get Together, Compare Notes, Add Percentage, Then Allot Work to Suit Themselves—Secretary Meredith Examined by Crown Attorney.

The investigation into the alleged combine between the master plumbers and the supply association, to boost prices was commenced in real earnest yesterday morning in police court before Magistrate Denison.

Crown Attorney Curry, the lone prosecutor, had a stack of books, papers, etc., which he had procured in the offices of the secretary of the Plumbers' Association, the Supply Association and the Plumbers' Union, piled in front of him on a table. Opposed to him were W. R. Riddell, K.C., A. F. Lobb, S. C. Smoke and D. J. O'Donoghue.

The alleged conspirators are: Louis Le Grew, Robert W. Harrison, W. J. Mason, W. J. Storey, Chas. H. Bevan, Chas. J. Connor, J. Allison, Fred Armstrong, F. Lawlor and Patrick Hayes, W. H. Meredith, Wm. Bush, W. H. Curlick, and A. A. McMichael.

W. H. Meredith, secretary of the Master Plumbers' and Steamfitters' Association, held the centre of the stage all day. He admitted in the witness box an agreement had been entered into between the Plumbers' Association and the Supply Association. This is the agreement:

"Whereas negotiations have been under way for some months between the parties hereto, with a view to improving the conditions of the trade generally, and to protect the Master Plumbers' and Steamfitters' Association by giving the association a preference over non-members on all plumbing and steamfitting goods purchased from the undersigned firms:

"It is hereby agreed between the parties hereto as follows:

"That the members of the Master Plumbers' and Steamfitters' Association will endeavor to buy all goods for their work from, and will give a preference on all purchases where prices are equal to, the jobbing and supply houses which are members of the association.

"That the undersigned supply houses will not sell to the general public plumbing goods, steam, hot water or gas fittings (except steam traps) at a price lower than that offered to the trade generally, except at a special sale.

"That the undersigned supply houses will not sell plumbing goods or steam, hot water or gas fittings (except steam traps) at a price lower than that offered to the trade generally, except at a special sale.

ROOSEVELT'S STRONG MESSAGE.

Railway Rate Legislation and Insurance Control to Be Dealt With.

Washington, D.C., Nov. 14.—President Roosevelt's message to the 59th congress has been completed and is in type. It may be said that the coming of the message is one of the strongest and most vigorous thus far written by President Roosevelt. It is considerably longer than last year's message, because it deals with a great number of topics. The most important portion of the message is that dealing with the subject of railway rate legislation. The president's recommendations are practically the same as those contained in his message of a year ago.

An unimportant and effective section deals with the subject of the Panama Canal. The president recommends the necessity of immediate legislation which will make it possible for the secretary of the treasury to dispose of the \$15,000,000 bond issue already authorized and to remove all doubt as to the authority of the commission to begin the work of the canal.

The president deals characteristically with the subject of federal supervision of insurance, recommending the enactment of legislation which will make it possible again to ascertain the financial condition of the companies.

LOOKS ON SEA LEVEL.

Engineers on Panama Canal Scheme Have Two Recommendations.

Washington, Nov. 14.—The foreign engineers on the Panama canal consulting board all favor a sea level canal for the Panama, while the American engineers are unanimously in favor of a lock canal. The conclusions have been reached at Panama and the reports will be prepared for the bureau.

The advocates of the sea level say that it is the better and more practical plan. The construction of the canal would be completed in sixteen years. It would long the Americans think it will take to build a lock canal has not been learned.

It was said recently by one of the members of the delegation that it would be the big seven years to construct one of the big locks needed at Culebra. Whether work on the other locks could proceed simultaneously was not stated.

TORREY-ALEXANDER REVIVAL.

The Horse a Sensitive Animal

Many persons believe that a horse's power of endurance is gauged by the number of miles he can travel and that Alfred Stoddard, in *Sublimity*, declares that "nothing less than a week's work, such as going to and from a station, even the actual distance being small, is enough to exhaust a horse." But the harness thrower, the general horse raiser, and the sportsman know better. They know that a horse is kept working, possibly in an overheated condition. The passing trains annoy him, the noise of the city annoys him, and many ways the task is an unpleasant one. Here he is kept working and injured one for one. He never gets a rest, and he is not allowed to strain upon the muscles, but he wears and tears upon his nervous system. He is not allowed to get his fullness. Rest with a horse is peace and quiet, more than it is pleasure. Indeed, some horses never down."

Liverpool, Nov. 14.—Broomhall's foreign crop summary: United Kingdom—A moderate decrease in the average is predicted.

France—The condition of seedling is generally satisfactory. Offerings are limited. Germany—Seedling is making fair progress.

Hungary—The developments are nominal as a result of fine weather conditions. Russia—The weather is wet, and mild, crop prospects are favorable. Southern provinces are slowly returning to normal conditions.

Italy—The recent rains have injured plowing and seeding. Spain—Good rains have benefited crops and prospects are bright.

India—An official report from Bombay stated that the Northwest Provinces, Central India and Rajputana, want rain, elsewhere prospects are fair to good.

Argentina—Rains have fallen, accompanied by frost, and the outlook is beginning to cause some anxiety.
