Nova Scotia Poultry Association Holds Annual Meeting.

The annual meeting of the Nova Scotia Poultry Association took place at the Agricultural College, Thursday, March 23rd, at 10 a. m.

Mr. E. C. Griffin, vice president, occupied the chair. Fifteen delegates from different poultry clubs of the province attended.

Mr. Frank R. Jackson reported that the poultry show held at the Sydney exhibition had not been improved. Interest in poultry at Nova Scotia was as keen as ever.

Mr. W. W. Osborne reported for Pictou county fencers and stated that a show had not been held in Pictou county during the last year.

Mr. R. J. Messenger reported for the Annapolis county club. The high price of feed and the scarcity during the past two years has retarded the increase of production.

Mr. E. H. Harrison, Antigonish, reported that a good show of poultry had been held in Wolfville during the past season.

Mr. Ambrose Rogers, the youngest delegate, presented the boys' poultry club of Guysboro and impressed upon the other delegates that Guysboro had some good poultry.

Mr. Landry, secretary, reported the proceedings of the Canadian National Conference held at Ottawa.

A resolution was passed asking the publishers of the Maritime Farmer for permission to use their paper as the official organ of the association.
