The estimates were tabled in the House of Commons, Ottawa on Monday night. They provide for nearly \$48,000,000, on consolidated account, besides some five millions on capital account. In addition to these estimates there will, of course, be supplementaries that will call for several millions more.

The Canada Gazette, of a recent date contains the financial statement of the Dominion Government, for the seven months of the fiscal year ending January 31st. The statement shows that the revenue for the seven months, amounted to \$32,545,486, almost as much as a full year's revenue, previous to 1896.

The civic elections, on Wednesday last were warmly contested, more interest being shown in them than for a number of years previously. Mayor Warburton, was reelected; but with an almost entirely new council.
