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JUDICIAL JOTTINGS.

The *Delibers* have been discharged in the cases Kroing vs Walls & al and Brissette vs Roberge & al and T. S.

The Record in RE Morin vs Brouilet, from the S. C. of Joliette, has been received to-day in the S. C. of Montreal for Review.

On petition of Moise Valade, hotel-keeper of Montreal, Mathilde Brabant, his wife, has been appointed his judicial adviser.

Leandre Céré, farmer, of St. Isidore has been appointed tutor to his minor child and Ls Porgue, farmer, of the same place, subrogate tutor.

Thomas Seery, of Montreal, blacksmith, has been appointed tutor to his minor children, and James Seery, subrogate tutor.

Romain Thyriou, minor son of Romain Thyriou, heretofore of Belgium, and now of Montreal, has been emancipated, and his brother, Louis Thyriou, has been appointed his curator.

The meeting fixed to appoint a tutor to the minor child of late F. X. Beaudry, took place at 10 o'clock on the 2nd of May. Rev. Mr Sentenne and the mother of the child were proposed and the nomination was taken *en delibere*.

In the case of Collette vs Bouvier mentioned in the list of Superior Court (Judgments), the Defendant is condemned to restore to the Plaintiff *es-qualité*, all the properties by him ceded to Dme Emelie Boisseau by virtue of a deed dated 7th March 1883 or, in default to pay the value thereof, to wit : \$6,333.50 with interest and costs *distrains* to Messrs Lacroix, Globensky, Bisailon & Brosseau, attorneys for Plaintiff *es-qualité*.
