The Anniversary of this Society was held in Cobourg Chapel, on Monday.

June 10th.

Mr. T. R. Hull led in prayer; the chair was occupied by Mr. J. Hodge, the President of the Conference; Mr. D. Cantlon read extracts from the Report.

Moved by Mr. P. Robins, seconded by Mr. J. H. Eynon:

1. That the Report, an abstract of which has been read, be adopted, and printed under the direction of the Committee; and we gratefully acknowledge the increased liberality of our members and numerous friends in supporting the cause of God during the past year.

Moved by Mr. R. Hurley, seconded by Mr. W. Hooper:

2. That in order to carry out the Divine purpose in the evangelization of the world, greater sacrifice, more strenuous efforts, and entire consecration to God on the part of the Church are essentially necessary.

Moved by Mr. G. T. Colwell, seconded by Mr. W. Woodman:

That this meeting returns its sincere thanks to the English Conference for the valuable accession to our ministerial staff, which they have kindly sent us during the year, in the persons of the brethren WEBBER, NEWCOMBE, and HEYSETT; and also devoutly acknowledge the gracious Providence of God in preserving these brethren, with Mrs. Webber and child, during the perils of their journey, and bringing them in safety to their destination, where, through the divine blessing, their labors have already resulted in good. And we further hope to have the number increased by at least three additional Missionaries the coming year.

REPORT.

The great commission and high destiny of the Church of Christ is to carry the word of life into every part of the habitable earth. But while the general principle and imperative duty is acknowledged, we must confess that a vast amount of indifference and apathy obtains among the professed followers of Christ on this important subject. Especially does this hold good in reference to Home Mission work, to which, as a denomination, we must for some time at least, chiefly devote our energies. What then, we would inquire, is our duty in this respect? We answer, to enter the great centres of population in this new but growing Dominion; to visit the back streets and lanes of towns and cities; to probe the festering wounds of moral corruption found there, and pour into them the blessed balm of Gilead; to enter the dark purlieus and dens of infamy, debauchery and crime, and offer mercy, pardon and peace to those who there wallow in vice; to reclaim the city Arab from civilized heathendom; to collect together and educate the teeming thousands of the young and rising race, who, inhaling the pestilential vapours of the immoral atmosphere, and influenced by the corrupt example of city life, in its most debasing forms, will, if not reclaimed, prove pests of society, and fill our beloved country with crime, if not with anarchy and revolution. All this, and much more in this direction, is truly and legitimately mission work. We must also follow the tide of settlement in this new country, and wherever the Backwoodman's axe is heard to ring, there the blessed and cheering sounds of God's economy of salvation must ring responsive notes of love and peace, of hope and joy. Neither must we stand appalled at the difficulties to be encountered, whether in connection with men or means; but, trusting in the promise, "Lo, I am with you," go forward prosecuting our great work till prosperity crowns our efforts, and victory emblazons our banners.

We are happy to record a good degree of success in our mission work during the past year. Many of the stations have been visited with refreshing showers of heavenly grace, and several have professed faith in Christ. A goodly number are reported to have died in the full hope of a blissful immortality. In finance there has been a large increase; the three Districts, Cobourg, Bowmanville and Exeter, being over \$800 in excess of last year.

We present our friends with a succinct view of the work of God on the Mission Stations, as abridged from the Pastor's report:—

On Peterborough Mission some of the societies have been visited with revival influences; and, during the year, 31 were received into the Church, most of whom are reported as giving promise of future usefulness in the Lord's vineyard.

The Dummer report says we are living in peace and unity, and evidencing an increase of denominational zeal, as shown by an increase of Missionary and Quarterly receipts. One of the greatest obstacles in the way of prosperity is the want of more spacious and inviting meeting-houses in which to worship God.

In Seymour Mission gratitude is expressed to God for his presence manifested in their assemblies; a few have professed faith in the Saviour: both the Quarterly and Missionary receipts are greatly in advance of last year; and they express the hope of soon ceasing to draw so heavily from the Mission Fund.

The Pastor of Huntingdon says "Though we have not had great prosperity, yet we have not labored in vain. Believers have found the word very precious; and unbelievers have found it both a hammer and a sword, and, yielding to its power, have become new creatures in Christ. Peace has generally prevailed in our Societies; our congregations are good, and our finances in a healthy state."

In Hungerford they express gratitude to God for the manifestations of his presence and power in the conversion of some precious souls. The congregations are good; but they cannot look forward with hopes of great success unless they can have a second preacher to assist in properly working the ground occupied.

From Perrytown we hear of the Societies living in peace, and realizing the gracious influences of the Holy Spirit; one new place has been opened with good prospects, and a Sabbath School has been organized; but the Pastor mourns over the Laodicean state of some of the members, evidenced in their neglect of the social means of grace, more especially class and prayer-meetings. Financially they have done well.

The Report of Pickering Mission thankfully acknowledges the goodness of God during the year. Two Chapel debts have been paid off, and the Quarterly and Missionary receipts are considerably in advance of last year. Spiritually, the station is taking higher ground: a decided improvement is reported numerically, with expectations of its continuance. They regret the want of more local assistance in working the station properly, and ardent prayer is breathed for an increase of this useful staff of laborers.

The Scott Mission Report also complains of the lack of Local help, and regrets many disappointments through the winter. They are encouraged by the increased liberality of the friends, and a Bible Class which has been well attended during the year.

In Oshawa, though they have not witnessed any remarkable outpouring of the Spirit, resulting in large ingatherings to the Church, yet they report "seasons of refreshing coming from the presence of the Lord," cheering the despondent, strengthening the weak, and making those of a fearful heart to be strong. They have heard the penitent's cry for mercy, and the jubilant songs of newborn souls. Two left the Church militant to join the triumphant hosts above. They have lessened the debt on their Chapel about \$300 during the year, and are in advance in Quarterly and Missionary receipts. The Sabbath School manifests a very cheering and encouraging aspect in all its departments.

In Prince Albert the influence of the Holy Spirit is gratefully acknowledged, accompanied with earnest breathings for more of the mind which was in Christ, as a preparation for greater usefulness and future prosperity. Financially they have done well. There are four Sabbath Schools in good working order. The Report says this Mission cannot be efficiently worked without a second Preach-

Mitchell Report breathes the spirit of prosperity : their special services have been seasons of much good in the conversion of souls, and the quickening of believers. The circuit has sustained loss in the removal by death of three of its staunchest members ; but they have left a bright testimony behind them that they have gone to be with Christ. The congregations are generally good : their Sabbath Schools were never more prosperous, promising, at no distant day, to prove a good nursery to the Church. Financially the Mission presents a brighter prospect than for many years. The Missionary meetings were seasons rich with Divine influences, and the receipts are over \$100 in advance of last year. The debt on the Parsonage all paid, and two new sheds erected.

The Report from London says: "A few have professed faith in Christ, and are walking heavenward. Congregations both in the city and country are good. We have commenced cottage prayer-meetings in the city, which we hope will be productive of much good. During the year we have expended in improvements on London Church over \$400, which has been all paid, and a surplus in hand. The contract for the erection of a brick parsonage is let, to be completed this summer at a cost of \$1000. Financially we have exceeded our utmost expectations : our Quarterly receipts are about \$30 and our Missionary receipts over \$80 in excess of last year. The Sabbath Schools require a more efficient and diligent staff of Teachers. To do justice to the city, and open other places in the country, we need a second Preacher.

In Dereham the Societies are reported as living in peace. In the town of Ingersoll 12 have been added to the Society, and the prospects there are very encouraging. A lot of land as a site for a Church, and, if needs be, a Parsonage also, has been purchased at a cost of over \$400 : aid from the Conference is earnestly requested to enable them to build.

The Pastor of Usborne reports a few conversions and the quickening of believers, but feels the need of more Divine influence to secure greater prosperity. The Quarterly and Missionary receipts are in advance of last year. The congregations are good. At Bethany a brick Church is to be completed by next fall. The friends in Bethel have seated and painted their Church, which is free of debt. Eldad Chapel has also been freed from a debt of several years standing; and at Freewill we believe it is contemplated soon to build a place for the worship of God.

The Grey Report expresses regret that so little progress has been made in advancing the interests of the Redeemer's kingdom ; nevertheless they have had some refreshing seasons coming from the presence of the Lord. The great want is more of the spirit and power of religion.

The Colborne Report says: "The year just ended has been one of trial and discipline : we have had much battling with sin and the devil, yet success has attended our efforts in the Lord's vineyard ; many souls have sought and found Christ ; several of the societies have advanced in spiritual attainments, and are in a better condition than they were twelve months since. The Quarterly receipts are in advance of last year—the missionary money nearly doubled. Steps have been taken to build a new church at Fishers', and for seating the church at Oasis ; and about \$80 expended on the Preacher's residence."

The Reports from Prince Edward Island District present the usual features of mission toil—light and shade—hopes and fears—joys and sorrows mingle

more or less in each. In Charlottetown they deplore the too frequent absence from the means of grace, of many who profess to be God's people, especially class and prayer meetings. They have been unable to do much in special services during the winter, owing to the unfavorable state of weather and roads: still a bright light appears in the cloud, in the increase of some of the congregations.

Vernon River report says, "While we feel sorry that we cannot report greater progress, yet we rejoice that the Lord has visited us with some gracious influence; peace and harmony and strong denominational attachment exist among us to a great extent. One of our members has left us for the joys of the better land: may we meet her when the storms and temptations of life are known and feared no more."

At Murray Harbor gratitude to God is warmly breathed forth for preservation from sickness and disease, which, during the year, swept through their settlements like an epidemic. The societies are reported as living in peace, and taking delight in the means of grace. The congregations are good through the entire circuit. The Sabbath Schools and Bible Classes are doing well, and commendable efforts are put forth financially.

At Grand River they complain of embarrassment in finances owing to the failure of crops in part, and also to the smallness of numbers: Still the friends have done nobly in the chapel building department. The sabbath schools are increasing in numbers and interest, the congregations are generally good, and the fields declared to be "white unto the harvest."

In Ebenezer and Bideford, though there has been no extensive revival, the cry of penitents and the shouts of new-born souls have greeted the ears and gladdened the hearts of God's children. Whenever the state of the weather and roads permitted the congregations have been good, and deep interest manifested. Death has been busy: among others called away has been Sister Kinley, daughter of Mr. F. Metherall, B. C. M. She fell asleep in the triumphs of faith. Sabbath Schools are promising, and finances satisfactory. At Ebenezer their new and commodious Chapel is to be completed by the 1st July next. Towards the erection £200 has already been paid, and it is hoped the opening services will realize another £100, which will place it free of debt.

The Pastor of Yorkville, U. S., says: "The remembrance of God's love to us, whether realized in the family, in the closet, in the sanctuary, or elsewhere, fills us with spiritual delight. The remembrance of our lack of love, of zeal, and of self-sacrifice, that we might instrumentally save more, and more fully glorify God, produces a sense of displeasure. The class and prayer-meetings have been but thinly attended; and the power of true religion has not been enjoyed in the degree that has been our privilege. A number of the Sabbath appointments have been broken up through the state of the weather."

In Lisbon they have been putting forth laudable efforts in Chapel affairs. The Union Church, now exclusively occupied by our people, has been repaired at a cost of \$177; the debt on the Parsonage (over \$200) all paid off, and additional furniture provided.

At Illinois matters are looking much brighter than at the commencement of the year. They have had seasons of great refreshing. Some who were halting between two opinions have come out boldly on the Lord's side, and they are confidently hoping for better days.
