

An Act to incorporate the Rideau Club.

WHEREAS, the persons hereinafter named, with a large number of Preamble... others in Quebec and elsewhere in the Province of Canada, have associated themselves for the establishment of a Club for social purposes, and whereas certain of the said hereinufter named persons have prayed 5 to be incorporated by the name of the "Rideau Club," and it is expedient to grant their prayer; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

85 ciation, shall be and are hereby declared to be a body politic and corporate, in deed and in name, by the name of the "Rideau Club," and by that name shall have perpetual succession and a common seal, Corporate and shall have power from time to time to alter, renew or change such powers.

common seal at their pleasure, and shall by the same name, from time 40 to time, and at all times bereafter, be able and capable to purchase, acquire, ho d, possess and enjoy, and to have, take and receive, to them and their successors; to and for the actual occupation of the said Corporation, any lands, tenements and hereditaments, and real and immova-

ble property and estate, situate, lying and being within the City of Ottawa, and the same to sell, alienate and dispose of, whensoever the said Corporation may deem it proper so to do; and by the same name shall and may be able and capable in law to sue and be sued, implead and be impleaded, answer and be answered unto, in any manner 5 whatsoever; and the constitution, rules, and regulations now in force, touching the admission and expulsion of members, and the management and conduct generally of the affairs and concerns of the said Association, in so far as they may not be inconsistent with the laws of this Province, shall be the constitution, rules and regulations of the said 10. Corporation; provided always, that the said Corporation may, from time to time, alter, repeal and change such constitution, rules and regulations, in the manner provided by the constitution, rules and regulations of the said Corporation.

- Property of 2. All property and effects now owned by or held in trust for the 15. existing asso-said Association, are hereby vested in the said Corporation, and shall formed, be applied solely to the maintenance of the said Corporation.
- Liability of members of the Corporation shall be liable for any of the debtu thereof, beyond a sum which shall be equal to the amount of the original entrance fee, an i the annual subscriptions which may remain unpaid 26. by such member; and any member of the Club not being in arrear may retire therefrom, and shall cease to be such member, on giving notice to that effect in such form as may be required by the by-laws thereof, and thereafter shall be wholly free from liability for any debt or engagement of the Club.
- Stock may be issued to a limited amount extent as they may deem necessary, not exceeding in the aggregate the
 sum of forty thousand dollars, in shares of one hundred dollars each;
 such stock to be subscribed for in a book to be opened for that purpose by
 the committee of the said Club, and to be paid up in such manner, and 85.
 within such delay, as may be determined by the said committee.
- Application of 5. The funds arising from such stock shall be applied exclusively to proceeds of the erection of a Club House and dependencies, and to furnishing the same.
- How stock may be assigned.

 6. The shares of such stock shall he assignable by delivery and sur-40 render of the certificates to be issued to the holders of such shares respectively, and by assignment on the books of the Corporation.
- Liability of stockholders. The Each holder of such stock, duly paid up, shall be a proprietor of an undivided share of the real estate of the Corporation, and of the buildings thereon to be erected, and shall be exempt from all liability 45. beyond the extent of the stock he shall actually hold.
- Corporation
 8. It shall be competent to the said Corporation to pay off so much of the said stock, from time to time, as the said committee may deem desirable; the share or shares so to be paid off to be selected by the said committee by ballot.

- O. Such payment may be made by depositing in any of the chartered Extinction of banks in this Province, to the credit of the holder or holders of such share or shares, the amount of such share or shares, and of all dividends unpaid thereon, and thereupon such share or shares shall, ipso facto, 5 cease to exist.
 - 10. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
