

Fresh Instance of Cana-dian Pacific Enterprise----A Through Train for Com-mercial Travellers,

The enterprise of the management of the Canadian Pacific railway company is manifested by their preparing to run, ba-fore the end of this month, a through train of admirably fitted up box cars for commercial travellers, with aleeping and dining cars attached, that will stop as that canvassing can be done all over the line. Each car will probably be used by two firms, and the charge for each half car and one traveller for the round trip from any point between Quebec and the Detroit river will be \$500, and from Win-nipg \$350. This gives about 3000 miles for the round trip leaves but little profit to the company. The occupant of each half car can use the space outside his por-tion of the car for advertising purposes. An entire car can be taken at a slight re-duction if only one traveller be sent. 


