A number of tourists of unknown boldness straggled to the summit. Ten years ago Fallaivi achieved the difficult ascent of the small to the great Glockner, the three first steps in the ascent of the Gross Glockner mountain in the North Alps, in the district of Tyrol, which is 15,000 feet in elevation.
