SAVED HER LIFE FOR HER SIN.

Sad Death of a Young Grey County School Teacher.

WAS BETRAYED BY HER AFFIANCED

And Expired Suddenly in a Toronto Lodging House.

Strange Remark of Her Lover, "I Paid The Doctor \$50 to Do That Job and If He Had Done His Work Right, There Would Have Been No Trouble." An Inquest to Be Held on the Body by Coroner Johnson This Afternoon.—The Affiliated Physician States That the Girl Had Been Subjected to a Criminal Operation of the Neck.

Miss Sarah James, daughter of Walton James, a farmer living near Hensley, P.O., Uxbridge Township, died at 49 Bellevue-avenue yesterday under circumstances which caused the authorities to suspect that death resulted from a criminal operation. An investigation has been set on foot, and Coroner Johnson has issued a warrant for an inquest at 3 o'clock this afternoon.

A School Teacher in Grey County. Miss James, who was a good looking young woman of 22, had been teaching school for some time at Corbin, Grey County. While there she became engaged to a young farmer named Albert Somerville of Bonda. The two were to be married shortly, and when school closed Miss James spent two weeks at her lover's home. Two weeks ago she called at the house of Mrs. Doherty, 49 Bellevue-avenue, and told Mrs. Doherty that she was not well and that Dr. Lehman of Spadina-avenue had recommended her to go to Toronto to board for a week or two, until she had recovered.

Mother and Lover Telegraphed For. The young woman gradually grew worse, and on Saturday last her mother and her lover were telegraphed for. They arrived the same day and remained with her until her death, which took place yesterday morning. Before she died, Mr. George Hewson, 71 Palmerston-avenue, a friend of the James family, was summoned to the house.

After the death had taken place Mr. Hewson had a conversation with Somerville, in the course of which the latter, according to Hewson's story to the police, said: "I paid the doctor \$50 to do that job, and if he had done his work right there would have been no trouble." No name was mentioned, and subject was not present.

Call at the head office of the North American, an officer was found dead in a room at the house, and arrived just in time to intercept Undertaker E. J. Humphrey, who had been called to the house, and was about to remove the body.

Instructions were given that the body be removed to the morgue, and the fact was notified. Later on it was taken to Humphrey's establishment, where it now lies.

Dr. Lehman's Statement. Dr. Lehman's statement, as given to the World last evening, is as follows: "A week ago last evening I was called to the house of a young woman, Miss James, who afterwards proved to be Miss James, who came to me and complained of sharp pains in the abdomen, and necessary for her, thinking she had a slight touch of inflammation. I saw her at intervals during the week, and I became a little suspicious. On the Tuesday following I decided that there was something wrong and questioned the girl very closely. She finally admitted pregnancy, and I thought the child was dead. I called Dr. E. King in consultation, and we decided that an operation was necessary. This was performed on Wednesday, and we took from her five months' foetus, which had no doubt been dead for some time. The poor girl gradually sank until her death yesterday."

"Do you think any instruments had been used?" "Either that, or she had been taking drugs, probably the latter," was the doctor's answer.

"You did not know the young woman or anything about her before she came to you?" "No, I have never seen or heard of her," the doctor answered.

Mrs. Doherty was also seen by a reporter, she appeared very much perturbed over the occurrence and expressed deep sympathy for the young lady and her relative. Miss James came to her home a week ago last Tuesday and told her she had been taken to Toronto. She said that Dr. Lehman had recommended her to come to Toronto to stay, and she was not well, and I took her in. I knew she was ill, but she did not take to her bed, and I did not think that it was anything serious until last Tuesday. As soon as I found out what was wrong, I wanted her to tell me where her mother lived. She would not tell me for some time, but she finally told me her mother lived at 49 Bellevue-avenue, and I did so. They both arrived on Saturday and stayed here until she died. They went away again this afternoon. Mrs. James said she expected her daughter to die, and she came to me, and wondered why she had not come. She was obliged to go home to-day, and I telegraphed her at the point of death in Uxbridge."

When Mrs. Hewson, 71 Palmerston-avenue, was interviewed she was very reluctant to give any information, but said that Somerville had made the statement to her husband with which he is credited. The parents of the young girl are wealthy and highly respected farmers in Uxbridge Township, and she admitted that she had betrayed her, is about 22 years of age, and is the son of a well-to-do farmer in the same township. He returned to his home yesterday, but will be recalled for the inquest. A post-mortem examination will be held to-day, and when the jury have viewed the remains to-night they will be forwarded to Ditch for interment.
