

## The Order for Morning Prayer.

The Service shall be the same as the usual Office for Holydays, except where herein otherwise suggested.

The Let the Minister read these sentences of Scripture; and after them the Exhortation, "Dearly Beloved, &c."

HE Lord is full of compassion and mercy: long suffering, and of great goodness.

He will not always be chiding: neither keepeth he his anger

for ever.

He hath not dealt with us after our sins: nor rewarded us according to our wickedness.

#### ¶ Instead of the Venite, Exultemus.

GIVE thanks unto the Lord, for he is gracious: and his mercy endureth for ever.

Let them give thanks, whom the Lord hath redeemed; and

delivered from the hand of the enemy.

Many a time have they fought against me from my youth up: may Israel now say.

Yea, many a time have they vexed me from my youth up: but

they have not prevailed against me.

They have privily laid their net to destroy me without a cause:

yea, even without a cause have they made a pit for my soul.

They have laid a net for my feet, and pressed down my soul: they have digged a pit before me, and are fallen into the midst of it themselves.

We acknowledge it thy goodness that we were not delivered over as a prey unto them; beseeching thee still to continue such thy mercies towards us, that all the world may know that thou art our Saviour and mighty Deliverer, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

After the Prayer for the Queen, [Almighty and Everlasting God,] shall be read the two Collects of the day, as in Morning Prayer, [Almighty God, &c. and O Lord who didst, &c.] then shall follow:

For the Epistle, Rom. xiii. 1 to 8.

ET every soul be subject unto the higher powers. is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God. Whosoever therefore resisteth the power, resisteth the ordinance of God: and they that resist shall receive to themselves For rulers are not a terror to good works, but to the Wilt thou then not be afraid of the power? do that which is good, and thou shalt have praise of the same: for he is the minister of God to thee for good. But if thou do that which is evil, be afraid; for he beareth not the sword in vain: for he is the minister of God, a revenger to execute wrath upon him that doeth evil. Wherefore we must needs be subject, not only for wrath, but also for conscience ske. For, for this cause pay ye tribute also: for they are God's ministers, attending continually upon this very thing. Render therefore to all their dues: tribute to whom tribute is due; custom to whom custom; fear to whom fear; honour to whom honour.
