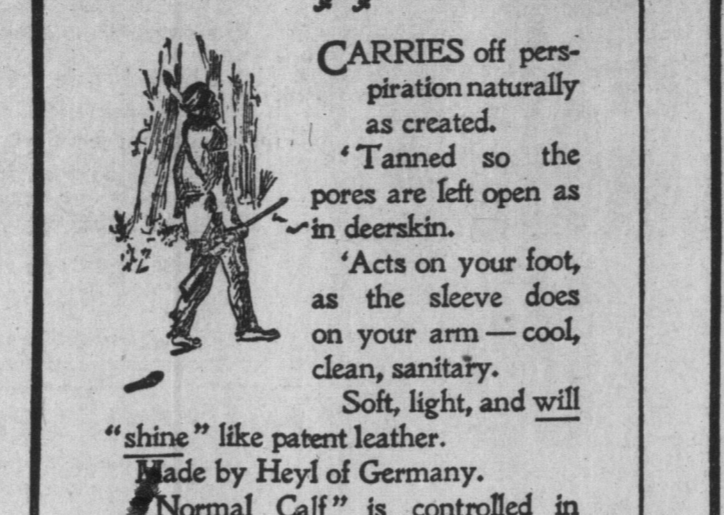

Case Argued in Supreme Court. Reopens a Neat Question. Washington, April 27.—One of the last cases argued in the U.S. Supreme Court before the suspension of the call of the docket yesterday, raises the question whether the constitution of the United States has ever been properly extended to Alaska, and also attacks the Criminal Code of that territory, which was enacted by Congress in 1880. The case is that of A. W. Corbin against the Alaska Treadwell Gold Mining Company, and the sections of the law which are attacked are those requiring the payment of an annual tax on the property, and the extension of the National Treasury. It is contended that the tax is unconstitutional, because it is not uniform, and that this must inevitably be extended to the territory. This point raises the question of the power of Congress to extend the constitution to newly acquired territory.
