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

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## ST. GEORGE'S SOCIETY.

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The annual general meeting of the St. George's Society took place at Russell's Hotel, Palace street, on Saturday, the 5th January, at four o'clock p. m.

In the absence of Mr. White, President, who had left for England on the day previous, the first Vice-President, Mr. Fitch, was called to the chair, and Mr. G. T. Cary requested to act as Secretary.

The chairman presented the report of the President.

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### PRESIDENT'S REPORT.

GENTLEMEN,—The Managing Committee of your Society beg to hand to you their annual report for the year just closing.

The anniversary of St. George's Day was celebrated by divine service at the Cathedral, when an excellent sermon was preached by the Rev. G. W. Innis, to a crowded congregation, and the collection amounted to \$88. The Musical service was admirably performed by the ladies and gentlemen of the voluntary choir, conducted by Mr. Mills, F. C. O., the Organist, with his usual ability.

Our Charitable Committee have spent \$520.41. as will be seen by referring to their report, and have done a larger amount of good than for many years; the various steam-boat and railway companies making a heavy reduction in their fares when applied to for passages by the Society

and in several instances the Richelieu Steam Company refusing any remuneration,--Capt. Jos. Hogg, of the *Montezuma*, and other captains gladly doing the same to assist the Society in husbanding its funds. Cases of this kind are worthy of record, and the parties mentioned deserve the thanks of all Englishmen for their liberality.

The great fire of the 14th. October, which devastated that half of the town where most of the laboring classes reside, caused much general distress. From inquiries, however, we found only one of our old members with a family had been burnt out. Thanks to the ready and bountiful subscriptions from England they have been well taken care of.

Since our last meeting, two new members have joined the Society.

At the same time we regret to have to record the loss of W. S. Sewell, Esquire, Sheriff; Edward Poston, Esquire, W. Hunt, Esq., and Captain James Bankier—all life members; also of Samuel Newton, Esquire, one of the original members, and also a life member of this Society, and at all times an active and zealous member. Eighteen years ago Mr. Newton was Vice-President, and up to the time of his death was one of the most useful members of the Committee of Management. Mr. John Lill, formerly a member, also died within the past year,

The Right Honorable John George, Earl of Durham, G. C. B. Patron. Died at Cowes, Isle of Wight, 28th July, 1840, at the age of 48 years.

The Right Honorable Lord Sydenham, G. C. B. Died at Kingston, C. W. September, 1841, at the age of 42 years.

The Right Honorable Sir Charles Bagot, G. C. B. Died at Kingston, C. W. 18th May, 1843, at the age of 62 years.

William Kemble, past President. Died at Quebec, 5th March, 1845, at the age of 64 years.

Charles Gibb Gortley Died at Dartmouth, 24th March, 1846, at age of 35 years.

Frost Ralph Grey, Died at Quebec, 11th April, 1846, at the age of 38 years.

James John Lowades Died at St Foy, near Quebec, 23rd July, 1846, at the age of 45 years.

The Right Honorable Lord Metcalf, G. C. B., Patron. Died at his seat near Basingstoke, Hants, 5th September, 1846, at the age of 62 years.

John Jeffery. Died at Quebec, 13th December, 1846, at the age of 63 years.

Anthony Anderson, born at Eldwin, Norumberland, 1768. Died at Hodley Lodge, Quebec, 3rd of April, 1847, at the age of 80 years.

John Racey, M. D. E. one of the Physicians to the Society. Died at Quebec 25th October, 1847, at the age of 39 years.

William Phillips. Died at Quebec, 4th April, 1849, aged 59 years.

John Charlton Fisher, LL. D., past President. Died on steamer "Sarah Sands," on her passage from Liverpool to New York, on the 10th August, 1849, at the age of 55 years.

Abraham Lenfesty, born at Guernsey, 1810. Died at Quebec, 13th July 1849, at the age of 40 years.

Thomas Yates. Died at Quebec, 13th July, 1849, at the age of 62 years.

William Benjamin Foster. Died at San Francisco, 13th October, 1850, at the age of 23 years.

William John Chajman Benson, native of Sepney, London, Died at Whitehall, U. S., 3rd December 1850, at the age of 33 years.

Peter Patterson, Native of Whitby, Yorkshire. Died at his residence Montmorency Falls, 12th June, 1851, at the age of 23 years.

Stephen Cushman, native of the City of Norwich, England, came to Canada in 1816, as an organist to the Cathedral. Died at Quebec, 6th October 1852, at the age of 56 years. The congregation have erected a tablet to his memory in the Cathedral Church.

William Patton, born at Low Leyton, Essex, England, 29th July 1789, came to Canada 16th June, 1819; seven years President of the St. George's Society. Died at Quebec August 1837, at the age of 55 years.

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Charles Poston, born at Whitechurch, Shropshire, 3rd October, 1788; came to Canada 23rd May, 1815; past President. Died in England, 5th April 1853.

Admiral Edward Boxer, C. B., born at Dover, Kent. Died at Ba'aklava, 4th June, 1855.

Peter Sheppard, native of Guernsey, came to Canada in 1809. Died at Quebec, 23rd August 1856, at the age of 63 years.

John Racey, Senior, native of Bath, came to Quebec in 1801. Died in England in 1856, at the age of 73 years.

The Earl of Ellesmere, K. G., visited the United States in 1854, as one of the Queen's Commissioners to attend the opening of the New York Crystal Palace, which made him favourably known to the American people. He visited Quebec also at that time, and was the guest of the Earl of Elgin. He expired at Bridgewater House, St. James, on Wednesday, the 18th March 1857. The deceased was born on the 1st Jan., 1800.

George Germain Ardouin, born at Quebec, 16th January, 1824. Died in Quebec, 23rd February, 1857, at the age of 37 years.

William Dupont, native of London, England, Died at Three Rivers, 8th November 1857, at age of 58 years.

Robert Roberts, born in 1797, Halkin, North Wales, came to Canada, 1819, Died at Quebec, 2nd July, 1858, at the age of 61 years.

Zaccheus Williams, born at Bangor, North Wales, 12th July, 1797. Died at Quebec, 19th November, 1858, at the age of 61 years.

John Robert Nathaniel Symes, Justice of the Peace, (senior Life) Member of the Society. Born at Camberwell, Surrey, 6th Jan., 1794. Came to Quebec, 22nd May, 1816. Died suddenly at the residence of his son, Dr. T. Fargues Syme, Corner, Meaford, C. W., 10th December, 1858, at the age of 64 years. Was treasurer from the formation of the Society, for sixteen years consecutively. The Society has erected a Monument to his memory in the Cathedral.

John Shaw, born at Devonport, England, 27 Oct. 1811, came to Canada, July 6, 1832. Died at Quebec, 5th July, 1859.

I. R. Eckart, born at Quebec, 16th March, 1805. Died by accidental drowning at Lake St. Charles, near Quebec, July, 1859.

Wm. Dawson, born in Sunderland, England, 1786, elected a member of the Society in 1837. Died at Quebec, May, 1859.

Francis B. Noad, born at Quebec. Died at Montreal, 18th February, 1860, aged 39 years.

W. W. Wheeler, native of England, Died at Quebec, 20th November, 1860, aged 45 years.

Henry LeMesurier, Justice of the Peace, born at Guernsey. Died at Quebec, 25th May, 1861, aged 69 years.

James Taylor, born at Northumberland. Died at Quebec, 15th, Nov., 1861, aged 46 years.

The Right Revd. George Jehoshaphat Mountain, D. D., D. C. L., Lord Bishop of Quebec, was the second son of Bishop Jacob Mountain, the first Anglican Bishop of Quebec. He was born, 27th July 1789, at Norwich, England, came to Canada, with his father, in 1793, and died after a brief illness at Bardfield his country seat on 5th Jan., 61. He was nineteen years Rector of Quebec and was consecrated Bishop, 14th February 1836. He was a diligent visitor among his flock. And in the dreadful visitations of cholera in 1832 and 1834 he literally lived night and day among the dying and the dead, while in 1847 when the province was visited with the plague of typhus fever, and the poor emigrants were dying by thousands at the Quarantine station, the Bishop took his turn at Grosse Ile regularly with the rest of the clergy; and again when the Cholera visited Quebec, in 1849 and 1854, he was diligent in visiting the hospitals. During many years and up to the time of his death, Bishop Mountain, besides his life membership, contributed regularly to this Society a donation equal to four annual subscriptions, and at all times he took a great interest in its proceedings.

G. B. Symes, born in Quebec. Died at Montreal, 12th June, 1863.

Barnard Thompson, born at Peckham, Surrey England. Died at Quebec, 18th January, 1863.

Henry Jessop, born in England, many years Collector of Imperial Customs at Quebec, died in England, 1863.
