An Act to amend the Naturalization Laws of this Province.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Naturalization Preamble.
Laws of this Province, and further to shorten the period of con- 12 V., c. 197.
tinued residence required by the Act passed in the twelfth year of Her
Majesty's reign, intituled "*An Act to repeal a certain Act therein men-*
tioned, and to make better provision for the Naturalization of Aliens;"
Therefore, Her Majesty, &c., enact as follows :

I. The Act cited in the preamble to this Act shall be so amended as
to reduce the term of continued residence required by the fourth section
thereof to three years or upwards, instead of seven years or upwards ;
and the words of the oath required to be taken under section five of the
said Act, or in any certificate or other proceeding, shall be varied ac-
cordingly. Required term

three years.

II. The Act passed in the eighteenth year of Her Majesty's reign,
chapter six, intituled "*An Act to amend the Naturalization Laws of*
this Province," shall be and is hereby repealed ; Provided always, that
the repeal of the said Act shall not affect the naturalization of any per-
son naturalized under it, or any right of any person acquired under and
in virtue thereof, but all rights so acquired shall be possessed and en-
joyed as if the said Act had not been repealed. 18 V., c. 6,
