An Act respecting Stamps on Law proceedings in this Province, and respecting also Stamps in lieu of Registration Duties in Lower Canada.

WHEREAS it is expedient that all Fees and Charges, payable to Preamble. the Crown, for or upon any proceeding in this Act mentioned shall be made in the manner herein provided:

Therefore, Her Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lgislative Council and assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

4. Every proceeding whatever, upon which any such fee or charge is Proceedings 30 due or payable to the Crown, as aforesaid, and which is not so duly not stamped stamped shall, if not afterwards stamped under the provisions of this act, be absolutely void for all purposes whatsoever.

5. No Sheriff or other Officer or person shall serve or execute any Sheriff, &c., proceeding, or the copy of any proceeding, upon which any such fee or not to serve 35 charge is due or payable, and which is not duly stamped under this unstamped Proceedings. Act, and every such service and execution contrary to this Act shall be void, and no recompense shall be allowed therefor.

6. No proceeding which may have been duly stamped for the pur-Proceedings pose for which it may have been used, shall be considered as stamped for each pur-40 for any other purpose, in case another fee or charge is due or payable pose for thereon for any other or further use of the same proceeding.

7. The Court in which any such proceeding is, or is pending, which on unstamped ought to be, but is not so duly stamped, shall not, nor shall any Judge of such Court take or allow any proceedings to be had or taken upon, or in respect of such proceeding, although no exception be raised thereto by any of the parties, until such proceeding has been first duly stamped. 5

Courts may ings to be sub sequently stamped in and on certain terms.

8. Any party to any proceeding which ought to be but is not so allow proceed duly stamped may apply to the Court in which such proceeding is pending, or to any Judge having jurisdiction in the case for leave to have the same duly stamped, and in case this act has not been knowcertain cases, ingly and wilfully violated, an order shall be made for the duly stamp- 10 ing of such proceeding, upon payment of such sum as may be thought reasonable, not exceeding ten times the amount of the stamp, and also the costs of the application.

And give retrospective effect to such stamping.

9. In all cases where the proceeding has been duly stamped under any order made for that purpose, the Court or Judge may give such 15 retrospective operation to such proceeding so duly stamped as may be thought just and reasonable, under the circumstances.

Fees or dues increased.

IO. All fees now payable or hereafter at any time to become payable to the Crown to the Crown for or in respect of any such proceedings as aforesaid, or for or in respect of such fees, dues, or emoluments now payable or 20 hereafter to be payable to any Clerk or Officer of any Court whose fees shall be funded, and who shall be paid a salary in lieu thereof, shall after the passing of this Act, or after the fees of any such Clerk or Officer are directed to be funded, be at the following rates:

Rate of increase.

All such fees less than ten cents shall be increased to and paid at 25 ten cents; all above ten cents and under twenty cents, at twenty cents; all above twenty cents and under thirty cents, at thirty cents; all above thirty cents and under forty cents, at forty cents; all above forty cents and under fifty cents, at fifty cents; and so in like manner all other fees which are not of a decimal amount shall be stated and 30 payable at the decimal sum in cents next above the sum at which they are so stated.

Penalty on Officers receiving or executing untrary to this Act.

11. Every Officer of any Court who shall knowingly issue to, or shall knowingly receive from any person, or shall knowingly serve or execute any proceeding upon which any such fee or charge is due or 35 stamped pro- payable to the Crown as aforesaid, without the same being first duly ceedings, con stamped under this Act with or for the proper amount of the said fee or charge due or payable thereon, shall be subject for the first offence to a fine not exceeding ten dollars, for the second offence to a fine not exceeding fifty dollars, and for the third offence to a fine of two hundred 40 dollars, and to the forfeiture of his office, together with the costs of the proceedings in every such case.

Penalty on persons receiving or de livering such unstamped

12. Every person who shall knowingly receive from or deliver to any Court, or receive from or deliver to the Officer of any Court, or shall knowingly serve or execute any proceedings whatever upon which any 45 such fee or charge is due or payable to the Crown as aforesaid, without proceedings. the same being first duly stamped under this Act, with or for the proper amount of the said fee or charge due or payable thereon shall be subject to such fine as the Court in which the proceeding is, or any Judge thereof on any summary application may impose, not exceeding 50 five dollars for the first offence and the costs of the proceedings, and not exceeding twenty dollars for the second or any future offence, together with the costs of the proceedings.

- 13. Every fine imposed by this Act shall be sued or applied for or by Recovery of order of the Attorney General or Solicitor General, in any Court having Penalties. competent jurisdiction as to amount, when no other mode of proceeding is by this Act specially mentioned, and the production of any such 5 proceeding unstamped, or stamped for too low and insufficient a sum, or the proof of any such proceeding having been unstamped or not sufficiently Proof in such stamped at the time when it was so issued or received, or served or cases. executed as aforesaid, shall be sufficient prima facie evidence of such proceeding having been knowingly or wilfully so issued, or received, or 10 seved or executed without being or having been first stamped.
  - 14. The Finance Minister shall issue the stamps required under Finance Minister to issue this Act.
- 15. The Clerk of the Process, or some other Officer to be appointed Farther proby the Governor, having an office in the city of Toronto, and vision for the 15 such Officer or Officers in such part or parts of Lower Canada stamps as shall be appointed by the Governor, shall issue all stamps under this Act, upon the request of any person who may apply to him for the same, payment being first made to him of the price or value of the stamps so required, and such Officer shall find such secur-20 ity for the performance by him of the duties of his office, and for the payment over and accounting for all monies and stamps received by him, as the Governor in Council may direct.
  - 16. All fines imposed by this Act shall be paid to such Officers in Towhom fines Upper and in Lower Canada respectively.
- 25 17. Such Officers shall monthly reader an account, under eath to the Accounts of Finance Minister, as hereinafter mentioned, of all stamps then in their stamps sold, possession, of all they have issued or sold, and of all moneys received by them under this Act, and they shall pay over at the same time all moneys which are then or should be in their hands as such Stamp Officers.

The copying or imitating of any stamp, issued under this Act Copying or shall be forgery, and shall be punishable as such; and the using again imitating Or reissuing of any stamp as for a new and valid stamp which has stamps to be 45 before been used, shall be a misdemeanor, punishable by fine not exceeding fifty dollars, or by imprisonment not exceeding one month, at the discretion of the court.
