





### PREFACE.

THAT every intelligent being should do homage to Him who gave this being, and continues it to him with all its benefits, is a principle so obvious as to require no reasoning to establish it. many, yea most among us, withhold this tribute so justly due. First, then: —We must pray to God as sinners, and through Jesus Christ. God will not hear us, unless we come to him through the Great Mediator; nor will he hear us, unless we come to him confessing ourselves sinners, guilty, and corrupted, having no righteousness of our own, and being unable to deliver ourselves from the state of condemnation in which we lie.

Secondly:—We must pray in sincerity, and in earnestness. It is to God we pray, and he is the searcher of the heart, and can only be worshipped in sincerity, with our hearts and not with our lips only. Earnestness also is inseparably connected with right prayer, considering how deeply we are concerned in the meaning and force of the words we use as sinners suing for mercy that we perish not.

Thirdly:—We must pray to God, as sinners, through Christ, in sincerity and earnestness, that he would mercifully pardon our guilt, on account of the Great Sacrifice of the Son of God, offered up on the cross for our sins, and accepted of God in our stead.

Fourthly:—We must pray to God, in the name of Christ who died for our sins, and who liveth to make intercession for us, that he would in his

Fifthly:—We must pray with the firm purpose and resolution of following God and the Lamb, devoting ourselves to the service and glory of our heavenly Father in all obedience and diligence, according to the directions of Holy Scripture.

Now, he who will thus pray, and will persevere unto the end thus praying and thus doing, shall be saved, and blessed with endless felicity. But he who will not pray at all, or who will not pray aright, shall have for his award everlasting perdition.

This little manual is offered to all who wish for some help in this great duty of prayer: and may God bless all into when the hands it may come, with life and glory everlasting through our Lord Jesus Christ.


