In making our appearance this morning to our readers in an enlarged form, we consider it necessary to explain to our friends, and the public in general, what they may reasonably expect from us in future, so that no mistake may be made as to the tendency of our writings, or to the peculiar political features of the Montreal Courier.

There is confessedly much in the late political aspect of the European Continent which calls for grave reprobation. Chartered rights, which had stood the test of ages, have been recklessly assailed; the sanguinary depravity of turbulent multitudes have risen above all law, and asserted their terrible right to innovate and destroy, because they had the physical power to effect their guilty purpose.

Yet we are not advocates for that stereotyped, petrified sentiment, which would have Governments to remain stationary from generation to generation, while science and the arts are hastening from point to point in their upward progress towards greater perfection, because this is contrary to nature—contrary to the great and paramount object for which man was placed in a state of probation here below.

tion among us, and it has also ceased to be in any measure the exclusive path of officers of trust and high consideration. Business among us, as among the Republics of the neighboring States, in any of the mechanical, commercial, or liberal arts, may lead to the great of deserved reputation and independence, justly entitling the possessor of any of them to the rank and title of a gentleman, whatever his designation may be at the Herald's College, provided always that integrity of character accompany his elevation. Nor is this latter quality to be expected in a greater degree in any rank; though among the high-born it may perhaps be distinguished by a more brilliant external polish. And it is thus that a middle rank, almost unknown among other nations, has sprung up in the midst of an ever-advancing and ever-advancing into our Councils, and halting, warping our credit, both at home and abroad, by their public spirit and by generous grants of those treaties which they had accumulated by honorable and intelligent enterprise under the protection of the British flag.

It was this feature in our national position that prompted one of the allied Governments when in London in 1814, to exclaim, when he had beheld for days together the ever-coming, ever-going, crowd of well-dressed persons passing his window, "Is there any one here who is not a noble, or at least a highly cultivated, well educated, and expensively dressed people?" His whole knowledge of man in society was confined to the two relations of master and slave. Jewels and rags, splendor and squalor, perfumes and stench, were the only features which his senses had been taught to distinguish among men. Graces of anguish and sympathy of man were unknown and symptoms of man were the only sounds familiar to his ear. The talented, titled artisan, the enterprising merchant, the princely capitalist—all of them more intelligent, more useful, more refined, say, and more independent than himself, in his Imperial State, surrounded by his guards, was a feature in the period drama of human life which he had never before found in his experience, or dreamt of in his philosophy.

To advocate a system so repugnant with the best interests of man, so filled with the most perfect national liberty, joined with the firmest bulwarks for the preservation of peace and prosperity, shall be our task. And though, from the corrupt efforts of rogues and selfish men, from the instability of Governments, and the impotent tendency of Councils—from the open hostility of some, and the secret machinations of others—from the abuse of power, and the mean servility of the governed—we have been, and may be still, constrained to look with a longing eye to the happiness and prosperity and freedom of those who claim with us the same ancestry, speak our language, and live in a great measure governed by the laws of our mutual self-interest; yet we shall proceed with what energy we may, to resist the criminal efforts of all restless men who would recklessly invade the bulwarks of the constitution without giving us an equivalent, and use every means within our power of supporting the true interests of civil liberty, and of maintaining the strongholds of religion, toleration, undefiled by the temptations of Roman aggression on the one hand, or infidel effort on the other.
