Meeting of Directors of the S. H. E. D. A. S.

A meeting of the directors of the South Huron Electric Division A. S. Society was held in Hattenburg's hotel, Brantford, on Wednesday the 12th inst. Present, the President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Messrs. Coleman, Cox, Spratt, Lamb, Pickard, Sproule, Geo. Anderson, Wilson and Hunter.

The minutes of last meeting were read and approved when the President, J. E. Dickson, stated that a delegation of gentlemen from the North Riding Society was in another room. It was resolved that the statements of said delegation should be heard at once.

The delegation, consisting of Messrs. Higgins, Fulton, Fowler and Gorenvick, was then admitted. Mr. Higgins said he had the honor of being the President of the North Riding Society, and that the delegation had come with a view of assisting in the union of the two societies, and to state the conditions to which his society would accede.

Mr. Gorenvick said that from certain reports and articles in the Social, they had been led to believe that the directors of the South Riding wished such a union. Mr. Higgins then stated in answer to questions, that the Clinton Association had seven acres of ground upon which was a large and appropriate exhibition building which they were willing to grant for a union show; they had also donated their spring show at Hylth, but if the South Riding Directors wished to have a union spring show, the North Riding directors would advance dollar for dollar with them.

It might have been rather shy for them to name Hylth as the site of their Spring Show, but it had been done by the directors and does not need to be said. It would be better to give their influence towards some other place for the fall show, if a union exhibition could be held in Clinton this year.

The delegation then retired. The President spoke of the progress that had been made in the House with the Agricultural Bill, and pointed out that the Committee had promised the County of Huron \$1400 without the reduction of any per centage, which would be a great advantage.

After a good deal of debate, it was moved by Dr. Coleman, seconded by Mr. Cox, that the Spring Show be held in Brantford-Carried.

Moved by Mr. Cox, seconded by Mr. Lamb, That it is the sense of this board that a union of bodies societies for the purpose of holding a Great County Exhibition would be most desirable in the interests of Agriculture, generally, in the County of Huron. The Fall Show could be held from year to year at such places as the Directors might select, and as Clinton appears to be the best prepared for such a show this year, and the delegates seem to favor the idea of moving the exhibition to that place.

A warning, long and ultimately rambling discussion arose, after which a motion was moved by Mr. Wilson, seconded by Mr. Anderson, That under the circumstances it is best to keep by our old site, and that the fall show for the South Riding for 1895 be held in Brantford, but it might be advisable to hold a union show every two or three years.

COMMERCIAL

BUFALO AND LAMB HORN R. R. The London North railway artery says the directors of the Buffalo and Huron Railway Co. have issued a note stating that up to the present they have been unable to induce the Grand Trunk Co. to accept any money on account of the revenue for the half year ending 31st December last, and consequently the bondholders' trustees are not in sufficient funds to pay the coupons. It is contended on the part of that Co., that no money is due until the accounts are fully made up, and as a different opinion is entertained by the Directors of this Co., they have suggested that the question be arbitrated in accordance with the agreement. The accounts may be expected in this country early in March, after which the bondholders' trustees hope to be in a position to pay the coupons.

ST. American is selling in Toronto, at \$1.25 a 75 cent lot, Liverpool coal \$1.20 a 100 lb. lot.

The Kentbridge well has reached a depth of about 300 feet.

The demand for Goderich salt is much greater than the supply. Although the well is worked to its full capacity there are still large quantities of salt in the mine.
