THE GOVERNMENT'S DEFENSE

The Canadian government has issued a pamphlet in defence of the late hanging of Riel. The pamphlet shows that Riel induced the Metis to rebel and then offered to sell them their country for \$25,000,000. In the first rebellion he sold out for a less sum. One thousand dollars was paid him and he abandoned his followers and left the country before Col. Wolesey had reached Winnipeg. There is documentary evidence to show that Riel was sane and sane until the day that he gave his birth and next to the man who trusted him so implicitly that they placed their property and their lives in his hands. In his last rebellion he spared neither priest nor layman—catholic nor protestant. Each was slain or despoiled with perfect impartiality, as circumstances admitted. To call such a man a patriot is to do violence to the memories of the long line of illustrious men who have won their place in the service of their country by their emotional outbursts of national feeling. The French Canadians forget the character of Riel in expounding the cause of the Metis. St. Laurent, Father Anand, who received his baptism, and who with him when he died, who closed his eyes after the guilty spirit had left his mortal tenement and who with his own hand laid him in the earth of the little catholic chapel at Regina, in his evidence for the defence at the trial of Riel thus spoke of the nature of the alleged treason:

"The claims of the half-breeds changed frequently after his arrival. Before that they wanted patents for their lands, scrip as given to the Metis in Manitoba, river surveys and exemption from the wood tax. The government replied to one of their petitions conceding the old survey of river lots. This was an important concession. The only remaining questions that remained were those of patents and wood rights. These were given a fair way toward settlement. About March 4th a telegram was received from the government making these concessions."

On March 4th, therefore, according to this competent testimony, the grievances of the Metis had disappeared, and to this fact the resort to arms at the instigation of Riel is attributable. Unless the agitation could be continued and a crisis precipitated, his plans for extorting money from the government would be dashed, and so the Duke Lake fight was fought on March 18th. The proof of Riel's culpability is overwhelming. Father Anand in his evidence said:
