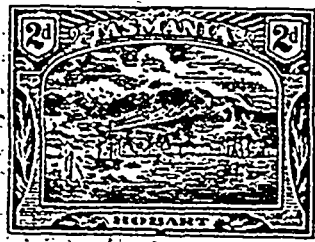

The COLLECTOR has given up its single handed struggle for existence which it has been carrying on for some months and is now incorporated with the New York Philatelist.

We congratulate the NEW YORK PHILATELIST on having such a successfully conducted department called "The Fraud Reporter." It is invaluable to dealers. But care should be taken that substantial proof of guilt is had before any person is slated as a fraud. It is possible for a person to be unjustly accused and the wrong done an honest person by publishing him as a fraud is a very

serious one and mere corrections and apologies do not by a great deal counter-balance the wrong done.

A. R. Magill, of Montreal will begin the publication of a new paper in January. It will be known as the *PHILATELIC RECORD*.

Now we herald another publication to be known as Philatelic Fun.
