PREFACE.

IN presenting the following pages to the public, the Compiler feels it a duty incumbent on him to introduce them by a few prefatory remarks, on the subject of the deviation from the original plan of publication. In the pamphlets on the British and Foreign Mining Companies, the plan adopted was that of furnishing copies verbatim of the original prospectuses, with a view of putting the Proprietors and the public in possession of the advantages held out by the Companies at the period of their formation, and making them acquainted with the names of the Directors and other Officers of the Company. The remarks on their progress and operations, obtained from authentic sources, with the Table and Summary, it was considered would render them more complete; and, in accordance with the original intention of the Compiler, it was announced, that a third part, on the same plan, embracing all the miscellaneous Companies, would be published at an early period. The impracticability, however, of giving the prospectuses verbatim of six hundred and twenty-four Companies, and the arduous and invidious task, in many instances, of reporting their progress and operations, induced him to alter the plan; and while he retained the more important particulars, determined him to exclude unnecessary and lengthened remarks, and confine himself solely to figures.

The inutility of publishing copies of prospectuses of abandoned or projected Companies will be self-evident; and, in the rejection, in every instance, of those details, it will, he trusts, be found that while it does not detract from the value of the present work, the information furnished will form a curious record of the extent of the speculations of 1824 and 1825, and be found generally useful and interesting to the public. In addition to the particulars of Joint Stock Companies of 1824 and 5, the Compiler has annexed a tabular view of the Joint Stock Companies formed antecedent to that period, which renders the work complete.

He deems it only right to observe, in closing these brief remarks, that the whole of the particulars given have been obtained from the original prospectuses and other authentic documents, (in the possession of the Compiler) and that all the calculations may be confidently relied upon, much time and attention having been devoted to the subject.

Having enumerated the titles of six hundred and twenty-four Joint Stock Companies, classed according to the best information which could be obtained, and with such particulars as could be relied on, we shall now proceed to a General Summary, which will at one view shew the extent of the various schemes of 1824 and 1825; and a cursory view of the Joint Stock Companies formed antecedent to that period. The impracticability of obtaining information in every instance must be the excuse for the preceding tables being of an imperfect nature, as well as for any errors which may be found; although, it is presumed, that the fault will rather be in the omission of particulars, than in the insertion of incorrect matter.

It will be observed by the foregoing calculations, (of the accuracy of which the compiler can speak with confidence, having devoted many months to the collection of the necessary prospectuses and documents, and having been engaged for a considerable period in arranging them and making the estimates,) that the total amount of capital required for the six hundred and twenty-four Companies, formed or projected in the years 1824 and 1825, was, the sum of £372,173,100, exclusive of many provincial Companies, and others formed in Scotland and Ireland, the capital of those Companies now existing amounting to £102,781,600.* The amount actually advanced, not including the premiums, was, £17,605,625; and that now invested in the Companies is £15,185,950, which at the present price of the shares may be valued at £9,303,950.

To ascertain more particularly the capital embarked in Joint Stock Companies, and for the purpose of rendering the table more complete, it is found upon reference, that besides the companies enumerated in the foregoing pages, there are one hundred and fifty-six Companies formed antecedent to the year 1824, and which now exist, (the titles, capital, number of shares, dividends, &c. are inserted in the appendix annexed,) the capital being £47,936,486 : 13s. : 6d. divided into 764,534½ shares, and the amount already advanced, £34,065,936 : 13s. : 6d.—the profits of the undertakings yielding in many instances a rate of interest far exceeding that obtained by any other mode of investment, and which may be classed in the following manner:—

Affording to the speculator and capitalist a fair and accurate view of the extent of the operations in Joint Stock Companies at the present period.

It is to be remarked of the Companies formed prior to 1824, that they are of a description, which individual capital could not be supposed to be adequate for the completion of the object for which the Company was formed. A majority of those formed during the years 1824 and 5, it must, however, be evident to the impartial observer were of a nature adapted only to individual enterprise, as by the formation of a Company many useless offices were created, and expences entered into, which would prevent the possibility of any profit arising to the shareholder, while the capital actually required was of so insignificant a nature, as to render the formation of a Company a measure, only to be attributed to some sinister motive of the projector.

In most instances, (confining the remark to those *particular* Companies), it will be found that the projector was either an attorney, who by the concoction of a scheme availed himself of the advantage which it afforded by a bill of costs; or some unprincipled person actuated solely with a view to pecuniary profit, and to obtain which, the measures adopted were in such cases neither justifiable nor honourable—the deceptive practices resorted to, the price far exceeding the real value of the property (in various Mining Companies) can only be explained by the guilty participation of the projector in the spoil; while in other instances by imposing on the proprietors of the Company by nominating a false sum as the purchase money, and by withholding the greater part of the shares, and disposing of them at considerable premiums, the parties secured to themselves a fortune at the public cost.* These premiums were obtained by an artificial value being created by manœuvres, and by the aid of individuals, who, for the sake of a commission, lent themselves to the fraud so committed; thus reflecting disgrace by their acts, on a body of whom many are of the first respectability, and hold in society a character for probity and honour worthy of example.

To acts of a similar nature to those referred to, is to be attributed not only the loss of property, but the sacrifice of character, which has, in too many instances of late, been the result of the proceedings of Joint Stock Companies, where, by the connection of honourable men with a

class of designing projectors, the innocent have been implicated with the guilty. It is, however, to be hoped, that the lesson thus taught the public, and more particularly men holding high stations in life, will be the means of preventing a recurrence of the events of 1824 and 1825, and that the base projector of the still baser scheme, will be shunned and stigmatized, while the patron and supporter of projects conducive to national benefit and the public good, will be held in that high estimation of the public, which it is their pride to bestow; and of the possession of which it is equally his pride to boast.

Before we close these brief remarks, it is, however, right to observe, that the appendix annexed affords an ample proof of the advantages to be derived from Joint Stock Associations, where the object is legitimate, and when carried into effect by honourable means. When we consider that to them is the country indebted for an advance of no less a sum than £34,065,936 : 13s. : 6d. outlaid in the formation of Canals, Docks, Bridges, Roads, &c. and to which we are also indebted for numerous Insurance Associations from which so much benefit has been derived, as well as those useful associations for the supply of water, gas, &c. no comment is necessary to prove their utility, and the policy of encouraging such modes of investment of capital, by the passing of an Act for their better regulation and management. In many instances the interest which accrues from the capital so employed, affords another proof that where care is observed, this mode of investment is beneficial to the capitalist, and to the nation; and that to decry Joint Stock Companies, or to listen to the murmurs of the disaffected and disappointed speculator without due caution and enquiry, is injurious and unjust. It has been the fashion of late to cry down all Joint Stock Companies: no one can deprecate the delusive schemes of 1824 and 5, more than the compiler, while he also feels convinced that to Associations of a similar nature we are indebted for many of the comforts we enjoy.

The particular object in the compilation of the preceding pages, was, to record the extent of the speculations of 1824 and 5, and to furnish a work of curiosity, while it blended information of interest to those who have invested their capital in the different Companies. In order, however, to render the view more complete, the names of the Companies, formed antecedent to that period, with amount of capital, number of shares, amount advanced, rate of interest, &c. as well as the amount of capital invested in the Foreign Loan, during the years 1824 and 5, have been annexed, although not comprehended in the original intention of this publication, by which it will be seen, that exclusive of the capital advanced in Joint Stock Companies, during that

speculative era, no less a sum than £25,308,468 was invested in Foreign Loans, contracted for at that period, making in all an actual investment of £42,914,093. For more particular information on the subject of the British and Foreign Mining Companies, reference may be made to the pamphlets lately published, by BOOSEY and SONS, containing the original prospectuses, copied verbatim, with names of Directors, information of progress, table, summary remarks, &c.
