Gloomy Forebodings That the Peace Conference Will Result in "You Must" and "We Won't."

Birmingham, Eng., Aug. 4.—The Post states that Sir Mortimer Durand cabled to Lord Lansdowne to-day the principal feature of the Russian and Japanese peace terms. The stipulations made by the opposing nations are of such nature, the paper declares, they have caused the conviction that the negotiations to bring the war to an end will be unsuccessful, unless one of the countries backs down.

ST. PETERSBURG HOPEFUL. St. Petersburg, Aug. 4.—The newspapers generally express satisfaction at the unexpectedly cordial welcome received by M. Witte in the United States, in which public opinion all along had been painted as being unfavorable to Japan.

JAPAN NOT OPTIMISTIC. New York, Aug. 4.—A London despatch to The Times says: "It is evident that strong indignation is growing up in Japan in consequence of Russia's attitude in regard to the peace conference. The newspapers point out that Japan's attitude toward the war has been studiously self-contained and moderate, and that Japan has carefully observed the international law."

Tokio, Aug. 4.—A report giving details of the final pursuit and surrender of the majority of the Russian garrison on Sakhalin Island has been received as follows: "An independent cavalry column on the afternoon of July 25 attacked the camp of the garrison and routed them."

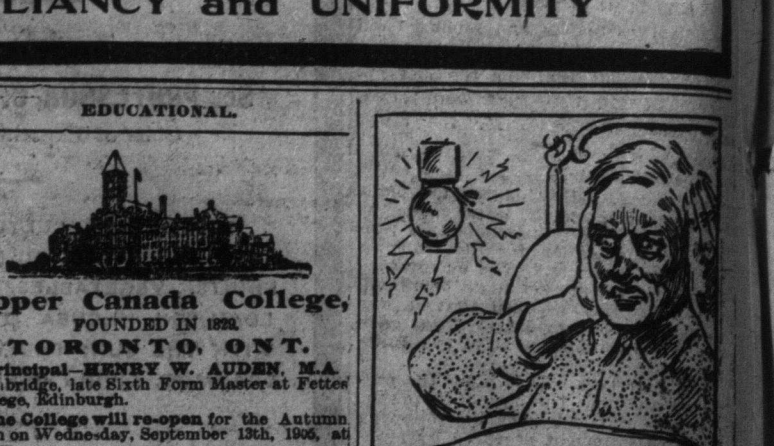
