

CHRESE FACTORIES.

The demand for American cheese in Estrope has greatly increased since the establishmens of cheese factories in which it is made on scientific principles, and of a superior quality. The consequence is that such factories are multiplying rapidly, and the keeping of cattle to supply them is extending in simil ar proportion. This will rapidly improve the soil, and increase its yield of other crops, so that what appears at first sight only to affect one branch of the farming interest, really affects all.

But it is clear that nearly the same improvement would take glace in butter that has taken place in cheese, were it also made in factories. The great drawback to Canadian butter is store-packing; that is, taking in lumps of many different qualities from many different farmers, and packing these almost promiseuously in kegs. In this way there are different qualities and colors in the same keg, and the whole has to be sold at the rate for the worst. Nay, if there are a hundred kegs, with five or ten kegs of this description among them the whole are likely to go at the value of the worst sample. Even when kegs are taken home by the farmer to be filled and brought back to the store, they are filled by successive churnings, and are consequently shadely always inferior to kegs filled at one churning.
