By order of the Minister of Shipping <br> Dated at St. John's, $\quad$ T. A. HALL, <br> 5 th day of December, 1918 <br> NOTE. -The effect of the above Notice is to cancel the supply of lots not exceeding ten tons of soft coal to any one person and to limit the amount to a half ton per household per fortnight. <br> Severe penalties are attached to any breach of the Coal Order of 18th July, 1918. <br>
