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SIXTY-FIFTH ANNUAL REPORT
OF THE
COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT
OF THE
ST. GEORGE'S SOCIETY
OF TORONTO
FOR THE YEAR 1899.

Your Committee of Management has great pleasure in presenting this their Annual Report, for the year ending 31st December, 1899.

The relief given during the year was much less than last, owing to two causes:—

- (1) A marked improvement in the labor market, therefore much less distress; and
- (2) Your Committee investigated many cases for relief of long standing, and a large number of applicants were struck off the list of recipients as not coming within the scope of the Society's operations.

It is fair to say, however, that no person was sent away empty-handed until the case was enquired into and reported on to your Committee.

The number of newly arrived immigrants assisted by the Society has been comparatively small.

On the whole the year has been a most successful one for the Society. Members have paid their fees promptly and willingly, and many who were remiss in this respect have again entered into active membership.

FINANCIAL.

The total receipts from all sources, including the balance of \$291.76, carried over from last year, amount to \$2,534.11.

The Treasurer's statement shows that the Society is on a thoroughly sound and substantial footing, free from liabilities, and with a goodly balance in the Bank.

As already stated, the balance at the beginning of the year was \$291.76; cash receipts were, \$2,242.41, making a total of \$2,534.11. The expenditure on all accounts was \$1,360.26, leaving a balance of \$1,173.85.

Included in this balance are the Life Membership fees received during the year, amounting to \$125, which, together with \$80 carried over from last year, made a total of \$205. This sum has been invested in a Canada Permanent Loan & Savings Co. Debenture, leaving a net

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balance in hand for the charitable purposes of the Society of \$958.85.

The Society here begs to acknowledge the liberal gift from Mr. W. H. Dean, a newly elected member, of \$50 for charitable purposes.

RELIEF.

During the year 590 applicants were relieved in the usual various ways.

Twelve orders for graves in our plot in St. James' Cemetery, were granted since last report, ten adults and two children.

MEMBERSHIP.

Thirteen Life and 118 Annual Members were elected during the year.

DEATHS.

We regret the loss by death, of, as far as we have been able to ascertain, eight Members, viz. :—

Life—Robert Spratt, Past President, 1865 and 1879; James Sadd, James Worthington, and A. D. Benjamin.

Annual—R. Jenkins, Stracey Lake, Charles Potter and W. F. Sexton.

By the death of Robert Spratt the society lost a warm hearted and kind friend, who never ceased to manifest a strong attachment for, and interest in our Society.

ANNIVERSARIES, ENTERTAINMENTS, ETC.

As usual, the Church Service was held in St. James' Cathedral, on St. George's Day, 23rd of April, which was attended by a large number of members of the Society, accompanied by a splendid turn out of the Sons of England. An instructive and patriotic sermon was preached by the Rev. Canon Sweeny, D.D., one of our Chaplains. The musical portion of the Service was beautifully rendered by the Choir, under the direction of Dr. Ham, Organist of the Cathedral.

Two successful smoking concerts were given, one on the 4th of April and the other on the 16th of October, which brought together a large gathering of our members, who spent two very pleasant evenings in each others company. Owing to the war in South Africa the October Smoker took a decidedly patriotic turn.

The Annual Banquet was held in our beautiful Hall, on the 24th of April. The attendance was the largest for many years, the feast excellent, the speeches patriotic and to the point, and when separating, the company expressed themselves as having spent a most enjoyable evening.

During the month of June, last, the Society, by request, made an exhibit at the Historical Exhibition, held in Victoria College building, Queen's Park. Photographs, Pictures, Banners, Medals, and Ancient records of the Society were sent, and the collection seemed to cause considerable interest on the part of the many visitors to the Exhibition.

On the 6th of October, Mr. J. Castell Hopkins, at the request of the Society, read a very interesting and instructive paper on "The Transvaal" in St. George's Hall. There was a large attendance of members and the general public.

The Rev. Canon Sweeny also entertained members and their friends on the 28th of November, by delivering a lecture entitled "London the Heart of the Empire," which was artistically illustrated with lime light views, by Mr. Whittemore, whilst the musical portion of the programme was under the direction of Mr. E. W. Schuch. The entertainment was greatly enjoyed by those present.

* In August last, the North America St. George's Union met in the City of Hamilton. Its Sessions extended over three days. Our Society was represented by the President and several other members. It was a very successful gathering, and a keen interest was shown by all present, in the affairs of the Union, which are in a satisfactory condition.

Mr. Alfred D. Wiggan, of Philadelphia, was elected President for the ensuing two years, and Mr. Thomas Y. Yeates again elected Secretary.

The honour was paid this Society of choosing our respected Chaplain, the Rev. Canon Sweeny, to preach the Bi-Annual sermon in Christ Church Cathedral, and in electing the President of the Society 1st Vice-President of the Union.

The Hamilton St. George's Society entertained the visiting members in a very liberal manner.

The usual Christmas distribution of good cheer was held in our Hall on the 23rd of December. All arrangements were successfully carried out; 668 families, representing 3,524 persons, received a substantial dinner and other good things.

After the distribution a goodly number of loaves of bread were sent to City Charities.

The photographs of Past Presidents Frederick Widder, 1849 and 1850, Robert Dodgson, 1861, William Kingsford, 1864, W. T. Boyd, 1866, John Crickmore, 1868, T. H. Marsh, 1876, S. Trees, 1877, F. B. Cumberland, 1883, and George H. Gooderham, 1898, have been added to our collection since the last Annual Meeting.

Two or three portraits are yet to be obtained in order to complete the collection.

Your Committee cannot refrain from referring to the dreadful war in which the Empire is now engaged, and which, up to the present time, has resulted in great loss of gallant lives; but as Englishmen, we are firmly of the opinion that Victory must ultimately rest with the British Arms, and the Union Jack be firmly planted in South Africa as a Symbol of Liberty to all mankind.

One good feature, however, has already resulted, it has done more than anything that ever occurred to unite the

Committee's Report.

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Empire, and bring the Motherland and her Colonies into closer relationship.

In conclusion, your Committee beg to thank the friends of the Society for their liberal support in the past, and hope for continued confidence in the good work done by the Society, also that success and prosperity may remain with us during the current year.
