MINUTES OF THE CONSTITUTION.

RULES.

- 1.—That the Association be denominated the "STADAONA RIFLE ASSOCIATION."
- 2.—That the subscription be \$2.00 per annum, but that non-commissioned officers and privates belonging to H. M. Regulars or to Volunteer Corps be entitled to a Membership on payment of \$1.00 each. And each Company of H. M. Regular Army or of Volunteer Militia whose officers are Members of the Association, and who pay \$5.00 to the Association, shall be entitled for every \$5.00 to ten Memberships; but, Memberships obtained in this way will only apply to non-commissioned officers or privates, and will not entitle the holders to any vote at any of the meetings; and none but subscribers of \$2.00 per annum or Life Members shall be entitled to a vote.
- 3.—Donors of \$20.00 at one time to the funds of the Association, or of a prize of not less value, to be competed for at the annual prize meeting, shall be entitled to be enrolled as Life Members of the Association.
- 4.—There shall be a Patron and Vice-Patrons.

The Lieutenant-Governor of the Province of Quebec shall be respectfully requested to become "Patron"

The Commandant of the Garrison and the Commandant of the Volunteer Force shall be Vice-Patrons.

- 5.—There shall be a President and Vice-Presidents. The President shall be chosen by the Council from amongst its Members; and the Vice-Presidents shall consist of the Asst-Adj. Gen. of Militia, the officers in command of the Regular and Volunteer Battalions, the Brigade Majors of the District of Quebec, together with the President of the Rifle Club, being subscribers, who shall also be *ex-officio* Members of the Council.
- 6.—The annual meeting of the "Stadacona Rifle Association" shall take place on the first Tuesday of May in each year, for the election of the Council, auditing of accounts, and for the performance of general business.
- 7.—There shall be a Council of nine members, independently of *ex-officio* members, who shall be elected at the annual meeting, five of whom shall form a quorum.
- 8.—There shall be a Secretary-Treasurer.
- 9.—The Council shall have the sole management of the funds of the Association.
- 10.—The prizes shall be competed for in accordance with such Regulations as may be passed by the Council from time to time.
- 11.—Nine members shall form a quorum at all meetings of the Association.
- 12.—The Council shall meet quarterly, or oftener, if required to do so by the President, or any three of its members, and shall keep minutes of its proceedings.
- 13.—The Council shall have power to elect a President at the annual meeting, and, from time to time, to fill up any vacancy in the Council, and to appoint a Secretary-Treasurer.

- 14.—All competitors for Volunteer Prizes shall be obliged to appear in the uniform of their respective corps.
- 15.—The preceding Rules shall be considered as permanent, and not changeable but by the concurrence of two-thirds of the members present at a meeting expressly convened for that purpose.

BY-LAWS.

- 1.—The Annual Subscription, payable in advance, shall be due on the first day of May in each year.
- 2.—Minutes of the proceedings of the Council shall be kept by the Secretary-Treasurer, and shall be open to the inspection of any member of the Council.
- 3.—All expenditure of sums for current expenses which may be required by the Secretary-Treasurer must be authorized by the signature of the President of the Association, or, in his absence, by that of two members of the Council.
- 4.—Other expenditure of a general nature is to be made only upon the authority of the Council of the Association.
- 5.—A detailed statement of all receipts and expenditure shall be rendered annually to the Council by the Secretary-Treasurer.
- 6.—No member of the Association shall be eligible to compete at any match who shall not have paid his subscription; and any member who shall be two months in arrear shall, ipso facto, cease to belong to the Association.
