Canada's Growing Time. An Ottawa despatch of Friday, 31st, says:—For the four months of the current fiscal year, up to the end of Oct. 31st, the customs collections of Canada amounted to \$12,311,618, an increase of \$1,651,000 over the same period of 1901.
