 A subscriber asks if there is any law
to protect treesp planted by a farmer，in
front of his farm．The Act to encour－
age the plantring of trees atong higwways
enacts as follow：－Any person owning
land adjacent to any highway may plant enacts as follows ：－Any person owning
land adjacent to any highway may plat
trees，shrubs or asplings on the portion
thereen thereof contageousto his land；but no
theree，
trhut or sappling thall be so plant－ tree，shrub or sapling shall be so plant－
that the esame is or may become a nui－
sence in the hiyhway or obstruct the fair and reasonable use of the same．
Every tree，shrub or sapling ose plant．
ed in the highwy shall for the purpoes ed in the highway yhall for the purposes
of this Act be deemed to be the property of the owner who planted the same．
Any person who ties or fastens any Any person who ties or fastens any
animals to any such tree，shrub or sap
ling so growing，or who injures or des． royss，or suffers or permits any animai in
his charge to injure or destroy，or who removes any such shrub，tree or or sapling，
or receives the ame remored，，hall，upon conviction thereoon
beforea Justice of the Peace，forfeit and pay such sum of money not exceeding Justice may award；and in default of
payment，the same may be levied of the goods and chattels of the petion offend
ing，or such person may
