Farm Notes.

Many farmers injure their farm implements more by exposure to the weather than by the use of the farm. An implement which, with good care, would last twenty years, will, when exposed to the weather, become useless in five years or even less.

Unless seed corn has been selected with care, it is useless to look for large yields. It is not a very costly matter for each farmer to procure half a dozen varieties of corn which in other places he knows have yielded heavily.
