How comes it to pass that the average price of all commodities were never so low in May as they are at this hour? The same cause, modicum and quantity, several hundred in number, representing more than seven-tenths of the entire consumption of the people annually, which would have cost \$100 in May, 1880, would now cost in the same market about \$75.00, a fall of nearly 25 per cent.

The decline was a slight greater at the lowest point in 1886, in August. It was about 1 per cent. greater at the lowest point in 1888, in July. But with these two exceptions, prices have never been as low in this country at any season as they are now.

To appreciate this statement it must be remembered that there is a peculiar rise and fall of prices recurring from the season; as products of the farm approach scarcity, before new supplies come forward, they are apt to command a higher price.

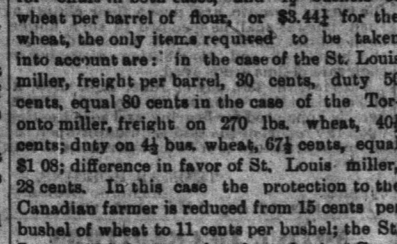

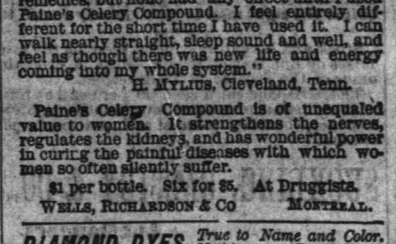
