RESOLUTIONS

Passed by the Church Society of the Diocese of Huron; sanctioned and approved by the Bishop of the Diocese.

Moved by the Rev. G. J. R. Salter, M. A., seconded by Rev. F. W. Sandys, D. D.:

Whereas it frequently happens that persons from various parts of the Diocese, and from other Dioceses, make application for assistance in building Churches, Parsonages, &c., to the Clergy and Laity of the Church throughout the Diocese, without any recognized authority and proof of the facts of the case for which application is made:—Resolved, therefore, that the Bishop be respectfully requested to establish as a rule in the Diocese that no Clergyman or Layman be permitted to collect money for any Church purpose beyond the bounds of his own Mission, or to proceed to any other Diocese for the same purpose without the sanction and approval of the Bishop, given as a heading to his Subscription List: and that it be the duty of such Collector to communicate with each Clergyman before he makes a collection in his Parish: and that, on his return from his collection tour, every person collecting shall present his Subscription List to the Bishop, and account for all moneys received. And further, that no person from any other Diocese shall make collections within this Diocese without first obtaining the sanction of its Bishop, under his hand and seal.

Moved by the Rev. F. W. Sandys, D. D., seconded by the Rev. G. J. R. Salter, M. A.:

Resolved, That inasmuch as great inconvenience and loss arise from the delay that too often takes place in making the collections for the Church Society and transmitting them to the Secretary, the Clergy are therefore requested to make collections one Sunday during the month appointed for each Collection, and to see that they are forwarded without delay to the Secretary.

Moved by Rev. C. C. Brough, A. M., seconded by G. Ryland, Esq.:

Resolved, That all applications for grants of money, books, &c., shall be submitted for the consideration of the Standing Committee previous to action of the Society thereon.

Moved by Rev. J. Gunne, seconded by Rev. J. W. Marsh, M. A.:

Resolved, That no change shall be made in the Constitution of this Society, unless notice has been given at the previous quarterly meeting; and, further, that all proposed changes of the Constitution shall be brought before the Standing Committee for them to report upon.

Moved by P. Roe, Esq., seconded by Archdeacon Brough,

Resolved, That the Lay Representatives of the Synod be considered *ex officio* members of the Church Society in so far as to enable them to attend and take part in all meetings of the Church Society, which may be held during any week in which the Synod meets during their term of office as members of the Synod.

CONSTITUTION
OF THE
Church Society of the Diocese of Huron.

ADOPTED BY THE SOCIETY AND CONFIRMED BY THE BISHOP, SEPTEMBER
22ND, 1868.

INCORPORATED FOR PROMOTING THE FOLLOWING OBJECTS

FIRSTLY—For the encouragement and support of Missionaries and Clergymen of the United Church of England and Ireland within the Diocese of Huron, and for creating a fund towards the augmentation of the stipends of poor Clergymen, and towards making a provision for those who may be incapacitated by age or infirmity, and for the Widows and Orphans of the Clergy of the said Church in the said Diocese.

SECONDLY—For the encouragement of education, and for the support of Day Schools and Sunday Schools in the said Diocese, in conformity with the principles of the said Church.

THIRDLY—For granting assistance, where it may be necessary, to those who may be preparing for the Ministry of the Gospel in the said Church, within the said Diocese.

FOURTHLY—For circulating in the said Diocese the Holy Scriptures, the Book of Common Prayer of the said Church, and such other Books and Tracts as shall be approved by the Central Board or Managing Committee of the said Association.

FIFTHLY—For obtaining and granting aid towards the erection, endowment, and maintenance of Churches, according to the establishment of the said Church in the said Diocese; the erection and maintenance of Parsonage-houses; the setting apart of Burial-grounds and church-yards; the endowment and support of Parsonages and Rectories, according to the same establishment, and the management of all matters relating to such endowment.

CONSTITUTION.

I.

That before the Society shall enter upon any business at any of its meetings, the following prayers shall be said :—

Prevent us, O Lord, in all our doings, with thy most gracious favour, and further us with Thy continual help ; that in all our works, begun, continued and ended in Thee, we may glorify Thy holy name, and finally by Thy mercy obtain everlasting life, through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

O God, from whom all holy desires, all good counsels, and all works of piety and charity do proceed, we beseech Thee to visit with Thy favour our Sovereign Queen Victoria, and so rule her heart, that she may in all things seek Thy honour and glory. Prosper with thy blessing the designs of this Society. Comfort with Thy grace those benefactors who contribute to its support. Bless the ministry of Thy servants, the Clergy ; the endeavours of all who are engaged in spreading the knowledge of true religion in this Province, and the labours of those Missionaries who are promoting the same in foreign parts. And may Thy Holy Spirit direct all our consultations to the advancement of Thy glory, and the good of Thy Church, through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

"O MERCIFUL God, who hast made all men, and hatest nothing that Thou hast made, nor wouldst the death of a sinner, but rather that he should be converted and live : have mercy upon all Jews, Turks, Infidels and Heretics, and also upon all those heathen nations upon which the light of Thy glorious Gospel hath not yet shone ; especially the Indians of this Continent. Bless the means used for their civilization and conversion, and take from them all ignorance, hardness of heart, and contempt of Thy Word : and so fetch them home, blessed Lord, to thy flock, that they may be saved among the remnant of the true Israelites, and be made one fold, under one Shepherd, Jesus Christ our Lord, who liveth and reigneth with Thee and the Holy Spirit, one God, world without end. *Amen.*

"OUR FATHER, which art in heaven, hallowed by Thy Name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive them that trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation ; but deliver us from evil ; for thine is the kingdom, the power and the glory, for ever and ever. *Amen.*

AND WHEN BUSINESS IS ENDED.

"ALMIGHTY God, Father of all mercies, we thine unworthy servants do give Thee most humble and hearty thanks for all Thy goodness and loving kindness, to us and to all men : more particularly for the providential support by which this Society hath been enabled to spread abroad the knowledge of Thy sacred truth. But above all, for Thy inestimable love in the redemption of the world by Thy blessed Son ; for the means of grace and for the hope of glory, which thou hast given us, in the same our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ ; to whom with Thee and the Holy Ghost be all honour and glory, world without end. *Amen.*

"The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Ghost, be with us all evermore. *Amen.*"

II.

That the Society shall consist of the Lord Bishop of the Diocese, and of all Clergymen and Laymen who shall contribute to its funds.

III.

That the Lord Bishop of the Diocese be President, and the Dignitaries within the Diocese be Vice-Presidents of the Society.

CONSTITUTION.

IV.

That the Corporation shall consist of the Bishop of the Diocese, of the members appointed by the charter, and of so many of the other members as shall be elected members of the Corporation at the meetings to be from time to time holden, on the day and at the place appointed by the by-laws of the Corporation for its stated meetings.

V.

That every incorporated member of the Society shall subscribe not less than five dollars annually, to the funds of the Society, or contribute not less than fifty dollars in one sum, or land to the value of one hundred dollars; and it shall be the duty of the Secretary on the first day of April in each year, to notify all incorporated members who have not paid for the current year, and at the meeting in the month of June in each and every year, to make a return to those who have not paid up the five dollars for the year ending the 31st day of May previous, and such shall cease to be incorporated members of the said Society.

VI.

That there shall be a Standing Committee (three of whom shall be a quorum,) to prepare the business for the meetings of the Society.

That the President, Vice-Presidents, Rural Deans, Secretary and Solicitor be *ex-officio* members of the Standing Committee.

That the other members of the Standing Committee, not exceeding twenty in number, being ten Clergymen, and ten Laymen, shall be elected by the Society, out of its incorporated members.

That of the Clerical non-official members of the Standing Committee, the four who, having been on the Committee from the annual meeting in June, have attended the fewest quarterly meetings, and the fewest meetings of the Standing Committee and of sub-Committees during the year, shall go out at the annual meeting in June. Should any doubt arise, the member or members who have served the shortest time on the Committee, shall be considered to have vacated his or their seats.

That the Standing Committee shall recommend to the Society at its annual meeting in June, four members, to be elected in the place of the four retiring clerical members, who shall not be eligible for the ensuing year.

That any member of the Society wishing to propose other candidates for election on the Standing Committee, be required to give in the names of such candidates to be proposed by them to the Secretary before the meeting of the Standing Committee in June.

VII.

That this Society shall at the quarterly meeting in June, choose one or more Vice-Presidents, in addition to the Dignitaries; one or more Treasurers; two or more Auditors; one Secretary; and such other officers as shall be thought necessary, provided that none but members of the Society be eligible to any office.

VIII.

That the paid officers of the Society shall be the Secretary, and an Assistant if required, and that the former shall furnish security to the satisfaction of the President and Standing Committee.

IX.

That if any vacancy occur by the death, removal, or resignation of any officer, notice of such vacancy shall be given to the Incorporated members of the Society, and the President shall appoint a successor until the next meeting of the Corporation.

CONSTITUTION.

X.

That the Corporation shall meet in London, on the first Wednesday in the months of March, September and December, and in the month of June on some day during the week in which the Synod meets, provided, however, that the Bishop shall have the power of changing the time of meeting in any of the said months if he shall see good cause, and the annual public meeting of the Society shall take place on some evening during the week in June in which the Synod meets. The President or Standing Committee shall have power to call a special meeting of the Corporation at any time.

XI.

That no act done in any meeting of the Society shall be valid and effectual unless the President or some one of the Vice-Presidents shall be present at such meeting.

XII.

That with regard to all meetings of the Society, and to the making, altering, or repealing any by-laws, rules or regulations, it is to be specially noticed that by the act of the Legislature, 7 Vic., ch. 68, it is enacted that no act of the Society, or meeting of the Corporation, shall be valid unless six persons of the Corporation, at the least, shall be present, and the major part of them consenting thereto. And, further, that no constitution, by-law, rule, or regulation of the Society; nor any abrogation, repeal, change, or alteration of the same, shall be of any force or effect until it shall have been confirmed by the Bishop, in writing, under his hand.

XIII.

That minutes of all the proceedings of the Society be taken, and that at each meeting of the Society the minutes of the preceding meeting be read by the Secretary, and signed by the Chairman.

XIV.

That the accounts of the Society be closed on the 15th day of May, in each year, that the same be audited within one month from that date.

XV.

That the Secretary conduct the correspondence of the Society, take minutes of the proceedings of the general meetings and committees, prepare the annual report of the Society, attend meetings of the associations throughout the Diocese, under the direction of the President, and take the superintendence of the affairs and the accounts of the Society in all its departments.

XVI.

That in order more fully to promote the objects of the Society, each congregation, in the persons of its clergyman and church-wardens, shall be a sub-association in correspondence, through its chairman, the clergyman, with the Parent Society, and may be denominated "*The Parochial Association of the Church Society*." The Committee, which shall consist of the above named, with power to add to their number, shall meet so often and at such periods as they themselves decide to be most convenient, inviting the co-operation of all the parishioners in their deliberations and designs. They shall collect subscriptions and donations from the members of the Church, in such manner as they shall deem most effective, and endeavor, by every means in their power, to augment the resources of the Society. All moneys raised to be transmitted to the Secretary of the Parent Society.

XVII.

That four collections be made annually, the proceeds of one of which shall be devoted to the Widows' and Orphans' Fund, and that of the other three to Missionary purposes; and at such other times and for such purposes as the Bishop may direct. The collections to be forwarded to the Secretary of the Society. It shall be the duty of every clergyman to give notice of these collections, and to call the attention of their congregations to the importance of the objects, and their claims for liberal support.

XVIII.

That all moneys shall be paid by cheques on the Treasurer, signed by the President and counter-signed by the Secretary.

RESOLUTIONS

PASSED AT THE FOURTH ANNUAL MEETING, HELD IN THE
CITY HALL, LONDON, ON THE 26TH JUNE, 1862.

The Annual Meeting of the Church Society was held in the City Hall, London, on Thursday evening, June 26th, 1862. The chair was taken by the President, the Right Rev. the Lord Bishop of the Diocese, at 7½ o'clock, p. m.—The Bishop read the appointed prayers. The Secretary read the report.

Moved by Hon. G. J. Goodhue, seconded by Rev. Dr. Boomer,—

1. That the report now read be adopted and printed for circulation throughout the Diocese.

Moved by A. Lefroy, Esq., seconded by Rev. G. J. R. Salter, M. A.—

2. That seeing that peace and prosperity are blessings which come from God, and that war, pestilence and famine are amongst the sore judgements which he inflicts upon nations; and that the former have been vouchsafed to our country, whilst others have been suffering from the calamities and horrors of war, this meeting desires to offer its humble thankfulness to Almighty God for his past mercies, and to acknowledge the duty which is thus laid upon us to abound more and more in love and good works.

Moved by L. Lawrason, Esq., seconded by Rev. E. L. Elwood, A. M., supported by Rev. G. M. Innes.

3. That the increasing population in the Diocese calls for renewed exertions in behalf of the objects for which the Church Society was established, this meeting therefore hopes that the returns for the coming year will be more in proportion to the work yet to be done.

Moved by E. T. Dartnell, Esq., seconded by Rev. Dr. O'Meara,—

4. That this meeting rejoices in the continued prosperity of the religious Societies in our Fatherland, and thankfully acknowledges the help which, through their liberality, is afforded to this Society in its missionary work and church extension throughout the Diocese.

FOURTH ANNUAL REPORT
OF
THE INCORPORATED CHURCH SOCIETY
OF THE
DIOCESE OF HURON.

In presenting their Fourth Report, the Standing Committee again feel constrained to record the signal benefits which have been vouchsafed to this Society, in common with all classes throughout our land, during the past year. When we consider that peace and quietness, prosperity, and a due return of the fruits in their season, have been allowed to our country by our Heavenly Father, we may well lift our hearts and voices in praise and thanksgiving. More especially is this seen when we contrast our present position with that of the inhabitants of the neighbouring States; where, alas, war stalks through the land, injuring the public interests of the community, involving the rich and the poor in one common fate, and crippling the resources of religious and benevolent institutions. Such might have been our position at the present time, had not the Lord of all the earth caused the dark clouds which were gathering around us to pass away; hence the Committee feel that it is more than ever incumbent upon the members of the Society to show forth, both by word and deed, their thankfulness to Him who has given us so many blessings in rich abundance, and who himself tells us "To whomsoever much is given, of him much will be required."

Seeing, then, that the income for the past year is somewhat less than that of the previous year, the Committee might at first sight almost think that there was a want of

appreciation on the part of our people of the blessings which we have enjoyed; but, when local circumstances are taken into account, and when it is remembered that the income last year was considered a respectable return, from a Diocese circumstanced as is ours, the Committee consider that they have no reason to despond, but rather that they have much to encourage them in the prosecution of the important and holy work for which the Church Society was established; when, moreover, we call to mind the intimate connection that exists between our country and our neighbours, and the interruption which trade and commerce have experienced, the Committee are more surprised and thankful that the difference between the income of the past and previous year is not much greater than that on the present occasion, they find themselves with slightly diminished funds.

. During the first three years a large increase was added annually to the income of the Society. This the Committee cannot look for every year; for, though they believe the maximum which the Diocese ought to subscribe is very far from being attained, still, the sum now sent in nearly approaches the capabilities of our people under present circumstances.

The income received from the Diocese for the past year is \$7,383.97, being only \$390.11 less than the previous year; this deficiency the Committee chiefly attribute to the omission of the collection heretofore made on the day of general thanksgiving—no such day having been appointed last year—and instead thereof a collection having been made to meet the expenses incurred on account of the Provincial Synod, an object which, it is evident from the returns, has not commended itself to the sympathies of our people generally. The total sum that has been received on account of the various objects of the Society, and from the investments and trust funds, amounts to \$52,965.88.

GENERAL PURPOSES FUND.

The sum received during the past year on account of this fund and of Parochial Associations and Annual Subscriptions is \$4,139.78, being an excess of \$224.11 over the previous year. From this fund no less than twenty parishes have received grants for Sunday School books or Service books to the amount of \$199.88, and thirteen churches have received help towards their erection or improvement,

amounting to \$770. Substantial assistance then has been afforded to the Diocese during the past year from this fund; and, as directed by the By-Laws, \$800 have also been carried to the credit of the Mission Fund, and \$320 to the Widows' and Orphans' Fund; leaving \$1,861.84 to the credit of this fund, to forward the work of the Society for the coming year.

WIDOWS' AND ORPHANS' FUND.

The sum received from the Diocese for this fund during the past year is \$602.68, being \$26.95 less than the sum received last year. In addition to this the sum of \$1,221.38 has been received from the principal and interest of investments, and \$320 from the General Purpose Fund, making the total sum of \$2,144.01; \$600 have been paid during the past year to three Widows, and \$2,108.74 have been invested. The balance at present to the credit of this fund is \$1,191.76; of this about \$1,000 can be immediately invested.

MISSION FUND.

The sum received on account of this fund from the Diocese is \$2,371.24, which is \$373.02 less than the sum received for the same object last year; for this deficiency in support of what is considered the great object of the Church Society the Committee is unable to account, except it be from the difficulty in obtaining a remunerating return for farm produce in many of the rural parts of the Diocese during the past year; for the Committee is loth to believe that any lack of sympathy exists in reference to this object in a Diocese where so great a want of Ministers of our Church is still felt.

In addition to the sum received from the Diocese, \$55.97 have been received through the S. P. G., given by friends in England for this Diocese, which the Bishop has directed to be placed to the credit of this fund. During the past year \$725 have been paid to Indian Schoolmasters and Interpreters; \$100 the annual pension to a retired Missionary; \$100 to Divinity Students, and \$900 in grants and outfits to ten Clergymen, besides \$2,005 devoted to assisting in making up the stipends of thirteen Clergymen, and \$126 in helping those Missionaries who receive a portion of their stipends from the S. P. G., making a sum of \$3,956 expended by the Society in support of Missionaries during the past year.

The Committee here rejoice to state that the S. P. G. have not only renewed their grant of £800, but have added £400 to it, thus making an annual grant of £1,200 sterling to this Diocese, for another period of two and a-half years from July 1st, next.

DEPOSITORY FUND.

No collection was made for this fund during the past year, with the exception of one parish, from which a voluntary donation was sent. A large number of Prayer Books and Hymn Books have been supplied to the Diocese, by means of this fund, during the past year; and a stock of books is still on hand, which, if all were sold, would leave a balance to the credit of this account, instead of as at present a balance appearing against it.

TRUST FUNDS.

COMMUTATION FUND.

The capital invested in Municipal Debentures to the credit of this fund is \$268,383, which, with \$625 cash in hand, shows an increase of \$3,196 over the sum received at the division of the Diocese. The interest received from this fund during the past year is \$14,763.17, which, with the balance in hand at the beginning of the year has enabled the Society to meet the Salaries chargeable to this account. Were all the municipalities to meet their engagements, there would be a balance from this fund at the disposal of the Society.

EPISCOPAL FUND.

A full report of this fund was lately drawn up and published by the Committee, which will be found in the appendix. So short a period has elapsed since that report was published, that little change has been made in the fund. When the recommendations embodied in that report, which have been adopted by the Society, can be carried out, this fund will be in a better position than at present to meet its liabilities. The Committee hope that this will be accomplished in part, at least, during the coming year.

CHRISTIAN KNOWLEDGE SOCIETY'S FUND.

By the liberality of the S. P. C. K., the sum of \$1,201.11 has been added during the past year to this fund, which is at the disposal of his Lordship the Bishop of the Diocese,

and from it eight churches have been helped during the past year; assistance has also been promised to several others which are in course of erection in various parts of the Diocese.

During the past year one of the Vice-Presidents of the Society has been removed by the hand of death—the late Absalom Shade, Esq. This gentleman ever took a lively interest in the affairs of the Society and the work of the Diocese generally, and was always ready, both with his counsel and with his purse, to forward the objects of the Society; and the Committee desire on this, the first opportunity, to record their high sense of his worth, and to offer to his widow and friends their deep sympathy in their bereavement.

The Committee must again record their thankfulness to those venerable Societies in England which continue to render them substantial assistance in their work in the Diocese, and they sincerely hope that ere another year passes away, the sad and unnatural war which is raging in the neighbouring States will have been brought to a close, and that the blessings of peace and prosperity will be experienced, not only in the land in which we are most deeply interested, but in all parts of the North American Continent, so that there will be nothing to cripple the resources of our country, and our people will be in a better position to assist in forwarding the great objects which this Society has in hand.

All of which is respectfully submitted.

EPISCOPAL FUND.

The following statement was adopted by the Standing Committee of the Church Society of the Diocese of Huron, at a Special Meeting, in accordance with a Resolution passed by the Church Society, on March 14th, 1862.

PRESENT.—Rev. R. Flood, V. P., in the Chair. Revs. W. Bettridge, F. W. Sandys, St. G. Caulfeild, J. McLean; L. Lawrason, Esq., W. Watson, Esq., C. Monsariat, Esq., J. Hamilton, Esq., G. Ryland, Esq., A. Greer, Esq., D. Phillips, V. Cronyn, Esq., Rev. J. Padfield, and the Secretary.

The standing Committee having been requested to put forth a statement relative to the Episcopal Fund, desire, first, to give a short sketch of the circumstances which led to the formation of this Fund, and the manner in which it was raised, as it is important that, when dealing with this Fund, these circumstances should be kept in view.

It will be remembered then, that, when the division of the old Diocese of Toronto was first talked of, it was made a condition that an endowment, for the support of the Episcopate, should be first raised by those interested in the formation of the new Diocese, as there were no funds available for this purpose to be obtained from other quarters, as had been the usage in all former cases, when new Dioceses were formed. To this arrangement the Imperial Government became a party, and it was conceded that, when a sufficient endowment was secured, the Bishop should be elected by the united suffrages of the Clergy and Laity within the bounds of the new Diocese; with this proviso, upon which the Governor-General insisted, that the minimum endowment raised should be £800, H. C'y., a year, with a pledge that exertion should be made to increase it, as soon as possible, to £750 a year, and that a residence should also be provided. In the years 1854, 1855, and 1856, exertions were made throughout the Diocese, most parts of which were visited by a deputation, duly appointed to solicit subscriptions for this object, and a Committee, consisting of seven Laymen of standing within the proposed new Diocese, was appointed by the Church Society of Toronto (the only body having the power at that time) to receive subscriptions for this object, and to prepare the endowment for the approval of the Governor-General. When the Committee received this Fund from the Deputation who had traversed the Diocese, soliciting subscriptions, it consisted of a small portion in cash, but the greater part was in Notes, securing subscriptions, varying from a few pounds up to five hundred, together with some promises from various parties, some of which have not been fulfilled to the present day. The condition

upon which these Subscriptions were given, was that subscribers of £20 and upward, might, if they desired, give security on real estate, and pay the interest only so long as they pleased. Thus the Fund consisted, after a time, mainly of Notes and Mortgages on small sums, which in the beginning of the year 1857 amounted to over £10,000, bearing six per cent, and representing an income sufficient to meet the requirement of the Governor-General.

It was necessary, however, before the Government would consent to a division of the Diocese, that the whole, or most of the Fund, should be secured by Mortgage on real estate, and in large sums; hence the Committee made arrangements with various parties to receive the Notes and small Mortgages and the cash in hand, and to give in place Mortgages on real estate for larger sums. In this way the Committee invested the greater portion of the Fund in sums varying from £100 to £3,000; and the whole matter was laid before the Bishop of Toronto in the month of April, 1857, by a Deputation sent for the purpose, and the Bishop, having examined and approved of the same, waited upon His Excellency the Governor-General, accompanied by the deputation, and the Governor, having examined and approved of the arrangements made by the Committee, gave his consent to the proper steps being taken to elect the first Bishop over the new Diocese. In July, 1857, the election of the Bishop took place, on the understanding that the Diocese was pledged to the Government to provide an Episcopal Stipend of at least £800 a-year. Shortly after this, severe commercial embarrassment commenced, causing great depreciation in real estate in the country, which unfortunately during several years of great prosperity had been unduly raised in value, so that when the reaction took place it became, in like manner, unduly depreciated, and as the greater part of this Fund was secured on property so affected, much of the interest was irregularly paid during this period of commercial embarrassment.

After the incorporation of the Church Society of the Diocese of Huron, the management of this Fund was assumed by this Society, and all the securities, &c., were assigned to this Society by the Church Society of the Diocese of Toronto, and at the Meeting in March, 1860, the present Episcopal Fund Committee was appointed to examine into this Fund, and to endeavour to put it into such a position as that, as far as possible, it might meet the object proposed.

The standing Committee consider that the best statement that they can give of the Episcopal Fund, is to publish the various reports made by this Committee to the Society, since their appointment to the present time.

In June, 1860, the Committee made a report to the Society, of which the following is a brief summary:

The Committee examined the Securities, which they classified in the following manner—

The Committee considered that £2,757 4s. 6d. could not be looked upon as reliable, thus leaving £9,661 9s. 4d. available for the Fund, so far as they could judge at that time.

The chief reason for this large sum being lost to the Fund, seems to be from the change of circumstances of many of those who subscribed, and the great depreciation of property in the country generally, which affected the securities given to to this Fund.

With regard to the Interest, the Committee found that there was the large sum of £736, 15s. 9d. due, reckoning to July 1st, 1860; but much of this being on securities which were not considered good, of course could not be depended upon to pay the Episcopal Stipend; while they found that no less than £760, 7s. was due to the Bishop to the same period, reckoning the Episcopal Income at £600 a-year, which was the minimum sum named by the Governor-General, and which the Diocese stands pledged to the Government to raise for the support of the Episcopate, as it was on this condition that the Government allowed the Diocese to elect its Bishop. The sum, £760, 7s. due to the Bishop for arrears of stipend, together with the sum voted toward his expenses incurred by his journey to England, and for his consecration there—making, together, the sum of £1000 0'y; it was resolved by the Church Society, in June, 1860, that this sum should be placed to his Lordship's credit, on the condition that, the interest thereon only be paid to him, the principal to remain as a debt due to the Bishop offsetted (as is explained toward the conclusion of this report) by his Lordship's liabilities to the Episcopal Fund."

In the month of June, 1861, the Committee made a second Report, containing a review of the Fund up to that date, which was published in the Society's Third Annual Report, and which is as follows:—

REPORT OF THE EPISCOPAL FUND COMMITTEE.

"The Committee appointed to manage the Episcopal Fund securities, beg to report that they have endeavoured, during the past year, to bring the Securities in Class B into such a position as would warrant their being placed in Class A.

"The present state of the Fund is as follows:—

"In addition to this, there are securities and notes representing \$8,141 90, most of which are considered so bad that the Committee recommend that for the present they be written off, as it is useless to burden the Fund with Securities, the greater part of which will never yield any return. The Committee, however, will not lose sight of these securities, and should any portion of them prove hereafter available, they will be added to Class A. The following statement will show the improvement effected during the past year:—

"Such is the present state of the Capital Fund; and with regard to the Interest Fund, your Committee have to state that it has not only paid the Bishop's Stipend in full since July the 1st last, and the interest on \$4,000 due His Lordship by the Fund, but has also met very heavy expenses connected with the King Street Property, and has paid the account of the Solicitor of the late Episcopal Fund Committee, and your Committee have full expectation that, even in its present state, the Fund will be able to meet all its liabilities for nearly another year, without asking any assistance from the Church Society, besides which they indulge in the hope that the Fund will show further improvement before the close of another year, even if it is not increased by additional donations and subscriptions.

In the month of December the Committee presented their Third Report, which, as it contains a review of the Fund, is now published in full:

"The Committee appointed to manage the Episcopal Fund Securities, beg to lay before the Church Society a statement of the present position of the Episcopal Fund, both as to its Capital and as to its Interest Account; and at the same time to make a few remarks and suggestions as to its future management.

"I. First as to the Capital of the Fund. When the Committee made their last Report, in the month of June, Class A, the only portion of the Fund from which the Committee derive any Interest, was stated at \$37,192 90; since that time the Committee have been obliged to remove \$1,180 00 to Class B, thus reducing Class A \$36,012 90, but by an increase on re-investment, they have added \$100 00, making Class A \$36,112 90, at the present time. This would produce an income of \$2,194 12, provided the Interest was all paid regularly, which your Committee regret to say is very far from being the case.

* Some ranked in Class A last year have been put down into Class B this year, which makes the gain appear small, but much of Class B will yet be found to be productive.

Leaving, according to present statement an annual deficiency of.....\$ 780 88 besides any law expenses which may be necessary, and the liability of further reduction in Class A, for the Committee cannot even now say that all the Securities in Class A are altogether to be depended upon.

" This sum cannot at present be depended upon to produce income, although a large amount of arrears of Interest is due on it, and the Committee fear that the largest portion of it will be lost to the Fund; but even if one quarter, or say \$2,000 00, can eventually be turned to account, it would add \$120 00 annually to the income; and yet this would leave more than \$600 00 annually deficient.

" In Class B, several large Mortgages are included, from which nothing has been received since July 1, 1857, but legal steps are being taken to put the properties on which these Mortgages are held in such a position that they may be made available for the Fund; and in April next the Committee expect to be able to offer them for sale.

" It is manifest then that some steps must be taken to assist this Fund; this is a contingency to which your Committee always looked forward; they had hoped, however, to have been able to put this off for three, if not for six months longer, but the unexpected decrease of Class A, by securities not paying interest upon which they had depended, and the unforeseen heavy drain upon the Income Fund, which will be shown under the head of " Interest Account," has compelled the Committee to bring this subject before the Society at its present Meeting, in order that steps may be taken without delay to put this Fund upon a sounder basis.

" The Committee consider that an absolute necessity exists at the present time of increasing the Capital or of subsidizing the Interest.

" To meet this, the Committee, after duly weighing the matter, consider that one of the following three plans must be adopted:—

“ 1st. By a vote of money each quarter to assist the Interest Account, or

2nd. By soliciting further Subscriptions to increase the Capital, or

“ 3rd. By voting a sum of money, or its equivalent, to increase the Capital so as to make it produce the Income required.

“ By adopting the first plan the necessity for an increase of Capital would be obviated, but it would be at the expense of a large pecuniary assistance each quarter, which would be a continual drain upon the only Fund which your Committee believe could legitimately be appropriated to this purpose. The surplus Interest of the Commutation Fund—and this, although the Committee propose a *temporary* assistance from this Fund, to meet the present wants of the Interest Account, they could hardly feel justified in recommending as a *permanent* means of meeting the deficiency.

“ With regard to the second proposal, to solicit further Subscriptions for this Fund throughout the Diocese and elsewhere, the Committee believe that little, if anything, could be obtained in this way at present, and moreover it would interfere with the annual demand upon the Diocese for the other objects which the Society is seeking to advance.

“ To turn then to the third proposal, viz., to vote a sum of money, or its equivalent, to increase the Capital; the Committee consider this to be the most feasible and most likely to produce permanent benefit to the Fund. *Money* the Committee do not believe the Society is in a position to vote; but there are several hundred acres of land * at the Society's disposal, for the general objects of the Society, which the Committee believe the Society may properly appropriate to assist this Fund, so long as it requires assistance, † and

* These lands consist of 1,380 acres given by several persons for the General Purposes of the Society, and which this Society received as its portion in the division of the funds and property of the Church Society of Toronto, and of 388 acres, which were also appropriated to this Diocese, as its share of lands given by the S. P. G., for the objects of the Society, and which have since been deeded to this Society.

† The following extract from the award entered into by the Church Societies of Toronto and Huron, will explain what is meant by “ so long as it requires assistance ” :—“ That the Church Society of the Diocese of Toronto shall execute a bond to the Church Society of the Diocese of Huron, in a penalty of ten thousand pounds, that on the death of the present Bishop of Toronto, the present Archdeacon of York and the present Archdeacon of Kingston, severally, the said Church Society of the Diocese of Toronto shall pay to the said Church Society of the Diocese of Huron the following sums: On the death of the Bishop of Toronto the sum of two thousand six hundred and eighty-six pounds, thirteen shillings and fourpence; on the death of the Archdeacon of York, the sum of one thousand three hundred and thirty-three pounds; on the death of the Archdeacon of Kingston, the sum of seven hundred and fifty-six pounds; and also on the death of all of the said three Clergymen, the said Bishop and the said Archdeacons, or on the first day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy, whichever shall first happen, pay to the said Church Society of the Diocese of Huron the further sum of one thousand two hundred and five pounds, thirteen shillings and fourpence;

as these lands as yet have brought in nothing to the Society, their appropriation to this purpose will hardly be considered objectionable. There are 1,768 acres, including 388 acres received from the Society for P. G. F., and these, added to the 300 acres already belonging to this Fund, will make 2,068 acres; these, if sold for say \$10,000 00, being about 5 00 an acre, would produce an income of \$600, to be added to the Interest Account; which would about meet the present demand. If these lands can be made to produce a larger sum, there will of course be a corresponding increase of Income, and the surplus over and above what is required for this Fund, should there be a surplus, could be dealt with by the Society as occasion requires, or, like the other Funds, it could be carried to the credit of the Mission Fund.

" This proposal to assist the Fund through these lands the Committee believe to be the most feasible and simple, and that it will prove the most satisfactory to all parties; and therefore they recommend that it be adopted. A list of the lands proposed to be appropriated is appended to this report

" The lands at present belonging to the Fund are—

" A Village Lot in Windsor.

" A Town Lot in Sarnia.

" 100 Acres in Enniskillen, and

" 200 Acres in Romney.*

" No revenue has yet been derived from these lands, while a sum of \$124 35 has already been paid for Taxes, and a further sum for the present year is still due.

" II. Second, as regards the Interest Account of the Episcopal Fund—

" The Committee will first briefly refer to the action of the Society in June, 1860.

" When the account of this Fund was made up at that time, it was found that there was due to the Bishop for Stipend at July 1, 1860, £760 7s. Od., reckoning the Stipend at £600 a-year, the minimum sum named by the Governor-General. While there was a large amount of Interest due the Fund to the same date. The Society then determined, provided the Bishop agreed, to allow this to remain as a debt due to the Bishop, and to add to it so as to make the round sum of £1,000, as arrears of salary, and compensation for expenses incurred by the Bishop by his journey and Consecration in England. This sum of \$4,000 has remained as a charge upon the Fund since July 1, 1860, and interest on it has been paid to the Bishop, but as the Fund has been receiving the same interest from

the whole of such payments to be made by the Church Society of the Diocese of Toronto in any Securities held by such Society at the time of such payment, bearing six per cent interest at their par value." By the agreement made between the two Societies, the Interest of these Securities is all to be applied to the Episcopal Fund, with the exception of \$400 a year, which is to be set apart for the support of an Archdeacon.

* This lot has been deeded by the Executors and Family of the late Col. Burwell, for the maintenance and endowment of the Bishop of the Diocese of Huron.

His Lordship on his liability to the Fund,* the Committee recommend that, in order to simplify the matter, credit be at once given to the Bishop for \$4,000, thus reducing the income, and also the claim upon it by \$240 per annum; but leaving the Income and its present Liabilities in exactly the same relative position.†

"The following Resolutions were passed by the Society, in June 1860:—

"*Resolved*—That considering the deficiency of Income arising from the Episcopal Fund, the Church Society hereby assumes and undertakes to make up the deficiency, so that the Bishop's Annual Stipend shall amount to six hundred pounds, exclusive of his Income from the Commutation Fund.

"*Resolved*—That \$4,000 be placed to the credit of the Lord Bishop of Huron, for balance of salary and expenses up to July 1, 1860, and that the same be allowed to bear Interest at the rate of 6 per cent per annum from that date until paid.

In accordance with this arrangement, the Committee have been able, up to this time, by means of the Interest due previous to July 1, 1860, added to the current Income, to pay the Episcopal Stipend and all charges against the Fund prior to October 1st last; and they had hoped to have been able to meet all demands by means of the Fund itself for some months longer; but owing to several Securities counted as first-class failing to pay Interest, and unexpected expenses being brought against the Fund, the Committee found themselves unable to meet the Episcopal Stipend due on that day, and the expenses charged to this Fund during the current quart. consequently the Interest is at the present time heavily in arrear, as will be seen by this statement given in this Report. Before, however, giving a statement of the Interest Account, the Committee beg to lay before the Society an account of the gross amount of Interest received by this Fund since June 1st, 1860, and of the heavy and unexpected charges which they have had to meet, which will show clearly the difficulties they have had to contend with.

* The Bishop's liability to the Fund consists of—Firstly, a Mortgage given to secure his Subscription of \$2,000 to this Fund; and, secondly, money advanced to him by the former Committee to meet his expenses incurred in his journey to England, in 1857, for Consecration, and for which the Society holds security. The Bishop pays interest upon these sums to the Fund.

† In making this arrangement to place this as an offset against the Bishop's liability to the Fund, as about \$1,600 of this can be placed against Interest which has been capitalized in the purchase of the King street property from Dr. Going; therefore it is only \$2,400, which, for the present, is carried from the Capital to the Interest Account of this Fund, and the Society has since decided, by Resolution, that the Interest Fund shall repay this to the Capital Fund, from time to time, so soon as it shall be in a position to do so after meeting its Liabilities.

The Society will easily understand by the above statement why the Committee is obliged to come before them to ask for assistance sooner than they had anticipated, from repairs on King street property, arrears of Taxes on various lands, and other disbursements coming in so heavily and unexpectedly.

The following is a statement of the Interest Account, as it will stand on the first of January next, supposing that the Interest were paid regularly :

Thus were all the Interest due on Class A. punctually paid on the first of January, there would still be a deficiency of \$517 22; but judging from past experience, this deficiency will be greatly increased by the want of promptness in paying the Interest due this Fund; hence the necessity of immediate action to meet this deficiency.

The Committee propose that this deficiency be charged to the Surplus Interest of the Commutation Fund, as the only Fund which they conceive can be used for this purpose; and that until the lands can be disposed of and made available for this Fund, supposing that the Society will concur in the recommendation made with respect to the lands, whatever sum may be required each quarter to meet the demands on the Interest, be also charged to the same Fund.

The Committee, in making this suggestion, of course, takes it for granted that the Municipalities will all eventually pay their Interest, although there may be a little difficulty at the present time.

Having now laid a full statement of the Episcopal Fund before the Society, the Committee will briefly recapitulate their suggestions, and recommend their adoption, unless the Society can point out some better plan, by which this Fund can be made to meet its liabilities.

First, the Committee recommend that the capital be so increased, that the interest will meet the demand upon it; and this they propose should be done in part, at least, by the appropriation of certain lands held by this Society, and that these lands be sold as soon as possible, and the proceeds invested for the benefit of this Fund.

Secondly, in order to simplify the accounts, that the \$4,000 due to the Bishop be at once deducted from his liability to the fund, as this will leave the interest account exactly as at present, and it will avoid the unduly swelling of Class A. beyond its real position.

Thirdly, That the present deficiency in the interest be charged to the surplus interest of the Commutation Fund, and that the same be continued each quarter so long as required, while class B. is being farmed, and until the lands proposed to be appropriated to the use of this fund, can be made available for income.

Should the Society adopt these suggestions, the Committee believe that the sum required from the Commutation Fund, will be diminished each quarter, until at length, when the lands are all sold and some other properties are made available, the demand will cease altogether.

The Standing Committee believe this to be a full statement of the Episcopal Fund up to the beginning of the present year, and the next report, which will be made to the Society in June, they hope and believe will show a further improvement in the fund,

The fund consists of securities representing \$36,112.90, producing at the present an income of \$2194.12, besides 300 acres of land, and two town lots, together with securities representing \$7,237.55, upon which, at present, the interest is not paid, and which is not, therefore, included in Class A. ; but the Committee still hope to see much of this added to their first-class securities. The fund has been, apparently, largely increased since it was submitted to the Governor in April, 1857 ; this has been done by additional subscriptions within the Diocese and elsewhere, including £1000 stg. from the Colonial Bishops' Fund ; £200 stg. from S. P. C. K., and 200 stg. from the Canada Company, besides private subscriptions, in England and Ireland ; but as a large sum has been written off, the present condition of the fund appears to be as above. The Committee believe, however, that, when the severe commercial crisis through which the country has lately passed is taken into account, they may justly congratulate the Diocese upon the present position of this fund.

The deficiency of interest to meet the Ep. Stipend and expenses, seems to be about \$600, if we take into account what may yet be added from Class B. to Class A. Now, to meet this, so as not to touch any of the funds contributed annually by the Diocese to the Church Society, it has been agreed to make use of the interest of the fund produced by the sale of certain lands held for the general objects of the Society ; and as by the award entered into by this Society with the Church Society of Toronto, certain securities are yet to be added to the Ep. Fund, at all events in the year 1870—this is only a temporary arrangement ; but which, under the circumstances, the Committee believe to be the best, and, as far as they can see, the only plan by which the Society, in its present position, can redeem its pledge to the Government and to the Bishop.
