Our new church was opened on the 20th of May, and we have had great comfort in worshipping in its ample and elegant auditorium, and in using its commodious and convenient school rooms.

The communion has been observed four times during the year; twenty-seven persons have been admitted to the membership of the Church; fifteen have been dismissed.
