




All races governed by the C. W. A. rules.

Position on the track will be drawn for on the grounds.

Where only two heats are run, the two first men in each heat are to start in the final.

Conditions of the Race.

Ride one-quarter mile, dismount, take a numbered spoon, pick up a corresponding numbered egg placed in the centre of the oval, and return, leaving both on the ground at starting point; then mount and ride $\frac{1}{8}$ mile, dismount and crawl through a numbered barrel, then mount and ride to starting point, dismount, pick up egg on spoon and carry to point where egg was first got, leaving both there, return to bicycle, mount and ride $\frac{1}{8}$ mile, dismount, get numbered spoon and egg, return with them to bicycle, mount and ride, carrying egg in the spoon to finish; dismount, handing egg in spoon to judges.

Egg must in all cases not be touched with the hands, and at all times carried in the spoon. Winners of the race to be the first three men crossing the line with unbroken egg.

Bicycles at all times must be left behind the mark except at the finish.


