### TO BALK THE BIG TRUSTS.

Malay Government Has Proposed Prohibitive Duty on Tin Ore.

London, May 25.—The Daily Mail's correspondent at Singapore states that the government of the Malay States has proposed a prohibitive duty on the export of tin ore, unless it is smelted within the colony. This step is said to be designed to check the export of tin to create a combine in the tin trade by the Standard Oil, the United States Steel Corporation and the American Tin Plate Company, who propose to import the ore into the United States free of duty, and re-export the smelted article.

### TO HAVE A MERITORIOUS ORDER OF HOME HELPERS

National Council of Women Decide on Important Step to Solve Servant Girl Question.

The Victoria Day meeting of the National Council of Women began with the singing of the National Anthem by the delegates. Miss Riddell then read the minutes of the meetings on Saturday, with many expressions of regard for the excellent work of the secretary.

The resolution of the Charlestown Local Council regarding the preparation of a handbook concerning the work of Canadian women, for the St. Louis Exposition, similar to the one issued at Paris, was introduced by Mrs. Macready. She explained the necessity for such a work being brought up to date, so that visitors to the Exposition would see that Canada was not behind other nations in any department.

The resolution was referred to the Executive Committee, on motion of Miss Derrick and Mrs. Ellis.

The next business was the report of the Committee on the Aged and Infirm Poor. Mrs. Cummings read this report on the absence of Lady Taylor. The question of the confinement of insane people and paupers in jails was dealt with vigorously, and the act of the government in compelling County Councils to erect poor houses, strongly commended. It was recommended that a bill be introduced to the Legislature should be urged, with the object of striking out the two-year residence clause regarding the reception of paupers into houses of refuge. The report was adopted.

The Servant Girl Question.

Miss Fitzgibbon then introduced the most exciting subject of the day, in a resolution proposed by Toronto Local Council to the effect that the National Council should consider the advisability of establishing an Honorable Society of Servant Girls, to meet the present condition of domestic servants. Miss Fitzgibbon went into the matter fully, showing that the preference given by the factory and shop work on account of the odium brought upon the words "domestic service." If a girl has a position as a stenographer or clerk, she moves in a society which a servant girl cannot reach because her own equals will not receive her. The girls are not given any freedom by many mistresses, but they prefer less money with their evenings and Sundays free. The Toronto Council had referred the matter to a special committee, consisting of Misses Massey-Treble, Torrington, Joy, H. S. Strathy, and Miss Fitzgibbon, and they were asked to report on the matter. The committee has reported that it is undenominational, and the applicant must be of good health and character, undergo a three-month training for one month, and agree to remain one year as a club during their leisure hours. It was estimated that there would be 6000 a year for three years, which would be raised in shares of \$10 each.

### SAYS CATHOLIC FASTING MAKES LEPROSY SPREAD

Prominent Surgeon's Investigations in India Lead to Somewhat Startling Conclusions.

London, May 25.—Jonathan Hutchinson, the well-known surgeon, and former president of the Royal College of Surgeons, who recently returned from a tour of investigation in India, as to the cause and prevention of leprosy, has written a letter to the Times on the subject of fish-eating as a cause of the disease.

He gives the opinion that the Catholic fast days are responsible for the spread of leprosy, and that wherever there is a risk of obtaining unseasoned fish, the use of fish on fast days ought to be forbidden.

"Whenever Catholic missions are successful," says Dr. Hutchinson, "leprosy increases. My calculation is that the risk to a Catholic convert is the same as to a Hindu, who remains in the Hindu faith."

### 200,000 MEN NOW ON STRIKE.

Extensive Additions Made Yesterday to Gotham's Idle Workers.

New York, May 25.—It is estimated that there are close on to two hundred thousands of men on strike in New York, as a result of strikes and lock-out by material men and contractors. On Saturday the number of men out of work was upwards of 170,000 and to these were added to-day 150,000 men locked out by the material men of Brooklyn, and another 10,000 forced to lay down their tools for the want of material which is at work on the most of the big buildings and in the saw mills and brickyards is practically at a standstill.

### TALBOT CENTENNIAL.

St. Thomas, May 25.—The concluding day of the Talbot Centennial celebration opened with Queen's weather and, at an early hour, people began to arrive by motor and train, so that, when the military parade started, the streets were thronged. The march was led by the Royal Grenadier Guards, 500 strong, followed by Lieut.-Col. G. A. Simson, the 24th Regiment of King's Own Rifles, 200 strong, and following them the local Collegiate Institute Cadets, 100 strong, and a contingent of the Canadian militia. The parade, which was a most successful and enjoyable, was followed by the new Armistice, which were formally opened, after which the military band, and a few de Jole was fired, and a march past was the order of the day. The Grenadiers were in progress during the afternoon.
