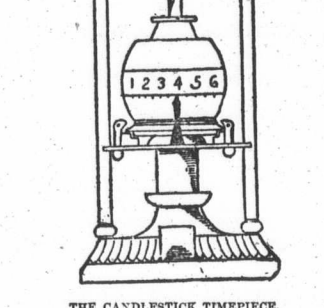

A CANDLESTICK TIMEPIECE

It indicates the time as correctly as a clock. A candlestick timepiece, as shown in the accompanying cut, says Invention, has been designed by a English inventor, which is said to be as accurate as a clock.

upon the candle is uniform throughout. A valuable feature of this candlestick is its simplicity. It has no parts depending on wheels or springs to get out of order.
