The third Division of the Superior Court was crowded yesterday morning with lawyers and parties interested, anxious to hear the decision that was to be given on the petition asking for a writ of injunction from La Municipalité du Coteau St Louis vs The City of Montreal. The question involved contained very important points of law concerning the interpretation of the federal and provincial statutes.

In a very elaborate judgment, Hon. Mr. Justice Taschereau reviewed the whole case and dismissed the petition with costs.

As our readers well know the Petitioner prayed that it should be forbidden to the city of Montreal to use the exhibition buildings as hospitals for those suffering from small pox.
