# NIAGARA ANNUAL CONFERENCE.

The Niagara Annual Conference held its Twenty-Sixth Session in London City, Ontario Province, commencing at 10 o'clock A.M. on the 21st day of April, A. D. 1869, being the Forty-First year of the separate existence of the M. E. Church in Canada.

BISHOP P. SMITH, D.D., and BISHOP RICHARDSON, D.D., were both present.

BISHOP SMITH presided in the opening services, which consisted of singing the 707th hymn, the reading of the 5th chapter of the 1st General Epistle of Peter, and prayer, led by D. Culp, T. Webster and Bishop Richardson.

M. BENSON was re-elected Secretary. C. S. EASTMAN and S. CARD were chosen Assistant Secretaries.

PASTORAL ADDRESS.

BELOVED of God, grace unto you, and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. Being once more, through the Divine watch-care, assembled in our Annual Conference, we again send you our pastoral greeting. Death has again invaded our ranks. Our beloved and efficient brethren, P. Smith, Jr., and J. W. B. Johnson, have been called from toil and suffering to rest and reward. May we follow them as they followed Christ.

The appalling prevalence of rationalism, ritualism and formalism, and of the culture of the spirit, customs and amusements of worldlings among professed Christians, demand that, with unflinching strictness, we adhere to the Divine command, "Come ye out from among them, and be ye separate. Receive ye the Holy Ghost. Be not conformed to this world, but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God, even your sanctification." This is emphatically the dispensation of the Holy Ghost; hence we enjoin upon you most earnestly the necessity and benefits of Holy Ghost religion,—the promised baptism of fire, even the fire of perfect love, illustrated in acts of continual obedience and Christ-like self-denial.

True, we regard order, ordinances, discipline, talent and truth as truly essential to sound Christianity; but even though these be as essential to Christianity as skin, and bones, and ligaments, and blood, and brains are in the constitution of man, yet just as truly as you may have before you all these in human form, and yet you may have only a paralytic, or even a corpse, so the Church may have all the essentials of the external, or form of godliness, and yet be destitute of the power, for God saith, "She that liveth in pleasure is dead while she liveth." As the body without the soul quickly becomes a loathsome carcase, a prey for worms or flame, so the Church without the Holy Ghost becomes obnoxious to God and disgusting to sinners,—the prey of the worm that dieth not, and the fire that never shall be quenched. But he that truly believes on the Son of God hath everlasting life. He that is filled with the Holy Ghost hath his life hidden with Christ in God; and the life he now lives he lives by faith on the Son of God, who loved him and gave himself for him. And he that hath this hope in him purifieth himself even as he is pure. He loathes the sins that once he loved, and looses his relish for the vain customs and fashions of the age, and for the popular games which amuse the vain and idle, and encourage the levity of the worldling and the associations of the ungodly, but cannot be taken in the name of the Lord Jesus. Knowing that whatsoever is not of faith is sin, he chooses, like his Saviour, exercise and diversion in deeds of love and relief to the bodies and souls of the widows and fatherless, keeping himself unspotted from the world.

We regret that after all the toils of another year for the ingathering of souls into the fold of Christ we cannot report any increase in our membership. We recommend increased humility and self-denial on the part of all, with solemn fasting and ardent prayer that God may send prosperity. We exhort you as aforesaid to faithful and spiritual improvement of the means of grace, and of the word of truth and the ordinances of the Church of God. Ever maintain punctuality and zeal for class and prayer meetings and similar duties, which being prominently spiritual, are too often neglected, and cannot be truly enjoyed unless the vanity and worldliness of self be sacrificed at the altar of entire consecration and ardent spiritual devotion.

Our Educational Institution, our Book concern, our Printing Establishment, our Missionary department, and other connexional institutions, though more prosperous than formerly, still demand your zealous co-operation and liberal support to give them efficiency and greater success.

Again we come to you to engage afresh in works of faith and labors of love, confidently hoping that in all things you will delight to be co-workers with us in the vineyard of the Lord. And now, be-



loved, building up yourselves in your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost, keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life; and may this Conference year be one rich in blessings to you and to all, to the glory and praise of God. Amen.

OBITUARIES.

Your Committee on Obituaries beg leave to submit the following:

Rev. Philander Smith, Jr., son of Bishop Smith, D.D., was born in Prescott, March 1st, 1835. When at the age of sixteen, while on a journey with his father through the western part of Canada, he was happily converted at a protracted meeting conducted by Rev. E. Bristol on the Barton circuit. After this he commenced the study of medicine; but his mind was not at ease; God had not called him to prescribe for the bodies of men; his was a higher work, that of directing men to the great Physician. He consequently left the study of medicine, and at the age of nineteen he was licensed as an exhorter by the Brooklin Q. M. Conference, and was employed by the P. E. and sent to labor on the Norwich circuit.— He had labored but six months when his health failed, and he was compelled to desist for a season. His health having improved, he was again employed and sent to the Walsingham circuit, and here, as before, he had labored but half of the year when he was again stricken down by disease, and brought very near to death's door, so much so that his eyes were closed by his friends and he was pronounced dead. But God had work for him still to perform. Souls were yet to be brought to God through his instrumentality. After recovering he, by the advice of Physicians, engaged for a length of time in the mercantile business.

In 1857 he was sent to the Blenheim circuit to supply the place of Rev. L. P. Smith, whose health had failed, and from this circuit was recommended to the Niagara Annual Conference, and was received on trial at the Conference of 1858, held at Willowdale. He traveled in succession the following circuits: Dumfries and Barton, one year each; Dunville, Smithville, Saltfleet and London city, two years each.

In his work Bro. Smith was faithful and energetic, and consequently very successful. As a proof of this we cite the fact that on every circuit, when he was in charge, his own salary as well as

all the sinners of the church were fully met; and on every circuit he has left as fruits of his labor, living witnesses that Christ has power on earth to forgive sin. In his disposition he was gentle and kind, and won the respect of all who knew him.

Being visited by his father in his last illness, he said, "Pa, don't pray for my recovery; I want to go and be with Jesus. I promised ma when a little boy, as I took her hand almost cold in death, that I would meet her in heaven. I see her on the other shore. The waters are opening; I soon shall meet her, and you will soon follow me."

During the whole of his sickness he was resigned, and always confident that to die was gain. With regard to his brother ministers, he said, "Tell them that I die at my post." His last words were in answer to the question, "How do you feel?" to which he replied, "My feet are on the rock; my feet are on the rock." Thus on the 11th of May, 1868, passed away in the prime of life one of the most faithful and devoted Christian ministers. The Church has indeed sustained a great loss; but they cannot mourn as do the parents, the widow and orphans.

Rest, brother, rest,  
Beneath the quiet sod;  
With faith and hope and prayer,  
We give thee up to God.

REV. JOHN WESLEY BYAM JOHNSTON died at Embro on the 4th of April, 1869, in the 31st year of his age.

He was married to Cynthia Mitchell, daughter of the late Rev. James Mitchell, of this Conference. He was grandson of the venerable Rev. J. W. Byam, also for many years a member of this Conference. The immediate cause of his death was bleeding at the lungs. He had traveled nearly five years in connection with the N. A. Conference and one year under the P. E. He traveled two years on the St. Davids circuit, one year on Dunville station, and nearly two years on the Embro circuit.

Bro. Johnson was a zealous, devoted servant of God, and was highly esteemed by his numerous friends, and his early death is mourned by all who knew him.

On the night before his death he requested that his wife should be awakened. This was the only time during his illness that he was able to converse to any extent. He wished to tell her and his mother, and all others present, how he felt. He said, "I am inexpressibly happy. I cannot find language to tell you how happy I feel." It seemed that his whole soul was in a flame of Divine

love. After this he could say but a few words at a time. Just before he breathed his last, his brother-in-law, Rev. J. McLean, said to him—"Wesley, are you going home?" to which he bowed his head in assent so distinctly as to be understood by all in the room. His death was triumphant.

### REPORT ON SABBATH SCHOOLS.

We have in the Niagara Annual Conference, as reported to us, 96 schools, with an attendance of 5,041 pupils, conducted by 790 officers and teachers, and also 101 Bible classes. In these schools there are 12,870 volumes and 318 papers. The expenses during the year, \$866.37. Conversions, 137. We regret that there is not a greater increase in our Sabbath Schools.

Our confidence in the S School work for the salvation of souls ought to stimulate us to renew our energy and to commit ourselves more fully to this great and glorious work.

*Resolved*, 1st. That, as a body of Christian ministers, we will devote more of our time, talents and influence in the religious culture of the youth.

2nd. Organize Denominational schools when practicable.

3rd. Introduce our catechism and literature into all schools under our control.

4th. Preach to the children at least once at each appointment during the year.

### SUNDAY SCHOOL UNION.

Report of the Board of Managers of the Niagara Annual Conference Sunday School Union, Auxiliary to the Sunday School Union of the M. E. Church in Canada.

1st. The Board of Managers of the Niagara Conference Sunday School Auxiliary Union are of the opinion that there is not as much

interest felt, and labor done, by our people in the cause of Sabbath Schools as there should be, and as there must be, in order to secure efficiency and general success throughout the Conference. We would therefore request our Local Preachers and Exhorters, when not engaged in filling appointments, to attend our Sabbath Schools, and give their influence in advancing this great cause.

And we would also earnestly request our members to attend the Sabbath Schools and take a more lively interest in them, as in doing this they will advance the interests of the Church, secure their own happiness, and glorify God.

2nd. That a Board of Management be appointed on each Circuit and Station within the bounds of the Niagara Conference for the purpose of organizing new schools where it is possible, devising the best means of efficiently working these schools now in operation, and doing any other work they may judge necessary to advance the cause of Sabbath Schools in the charge, in harmony with the Sabbath School Union of our Church; and that the said Board be composed of the Preacher in charge, as chairman, and the Superintendents of Sabbath Schools, working in harmony with our Sabbath School Union, with power to add to their number one member for each appointment on the Circuit or Station.

3rd. That the Circuit Board of Management be requested, where they may think it advisable, to appoint a visiting Committee to visit the families in the different neighborhoods in the charge whose children do not attend any Sabbath School, and if possible bring those dear, but neglected ones, to God's house, and instruct them in the things pertaining to eternal life. We are of opinion that if this system is thoroughly carried out in the several circuits hundreds of children now neglected will soon be gathered into our Schools.

4th. We recommend that our Sabbath School libraries be selected with great care, the publications being procured from our Book Room in Hamilton; and that the *Sunday School Advocate* be the periodical used in our schools.

5th. That appointments for Sabbath School Anniversaries be made in all the charges by the preachers in charge respectively, and wherever practicable, speakers from contiguous charges, or from abroad, be obtained to make such anniversaries more interesting and more successful. Or wherever it may be thought best by preachers on adjoining charges, they may unite in one anniversary by means of excursion or otherwise.

6th. That the object of this Sabbath School Union be explained at such anniversaries, and opportunities given to all present to connect themselves with the Union by the payment of 25 cents each.

7th. That all monies raised for the Union, either by collections or subscriptions of members, be forwarded directly to the Conference Treasurer of the Union, after deducting local expenses, including travelling expenses of speakers, &c.

8th. That all applications for aid to necessitous schools be made to the President of the Auxiliary, endorsed by the Presiding Elder. And the President shall forward the same to the Book Room at Hamilton for books, if so endorsed, and if the funds will admit, sending with the order to the Book Room a cheque on the Conference Treasurer for the amount of the books.

9th. That we request each Presiding Elder to present the subject of anniversaries to his first Quarterly Meeting and enforce the requirements of the Conference, that such anniversaries be held in each charge, the time being fixed by the Presiding Elder; and carefully inquire after the Sabbath Schools at each Quarterly Meeting.

10. We recommend the following as officers and Board of Managers for the ensuing year :

### REPORT OF COMMITTEE ON SABBATH OBSERVANCE.

The Committee on Sabbath Observance beg leave to report that—

WHEREAS the New Testament Scriptures teach the perpetuity of the command to "Remember the Sabbath day and keep it holy;" and whereas, many throughout our land, while they claim protection under our laws, violate them in practically denying the sanctity of the Lord's day, especially companies and government engagements, thus too often disturbing Christian assemblies as well as private persons in the worship of Almighty God; and whereas, there is in some measure a lack of zeal in both Church and State relative to this great evil;

*Therefore, Resolved, 1st.* That it is the duty of the Church, and more especially the ministry, to discourage this ungodly practice.

*2nd.* That, feeling the necessity of reform, we pledge ourselves to more earnest effort to bring the people to keep holy the Lord's day.

*3rd.* That we will aid in the different institutions of our land designed to assist in the great work.

*4th.* That we will preach at least one sermon on the observance of the Sabbath in each congregation during the year, and earnestly persuade men to keep the Sabbath day.

#### REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON TEMPERANCE.

Your Committee would respectfully report as follows:

That at the present, in this country, we regard intemperance as one of the greatest obstacles to physical health and longevity; to mental development and power; to social harmony and happiness; to moral character and conduct, and to religious life and prosperity. Except in cases of absolute medical necessity, it is evil, only evil, and that continually, and its certain effects are physical disease and death; mental debility and insanity; moral obliquity and corruption; social discord and misery, and religious insensibility and neglect. It makes this life a miserable failure, and the next "wrath and fiery indignation." We therefore most deeply deplore and decidedly disapprove of its present extensive legalized existence, not only with so many thousands of our common people, but with professional, municipal and legislative, not to mention professionally religious men. We would insist upon the strict and general observance of the injunction in our excellent discipline which prohibits all our people from the use of intoxicating liquors, except in cases of extreme necessity. We would urge upon our people the importance of giving their influence and suffrage to strictly temperate men for our municipal and parliamentary elections. We consider it the duty of both ministers and people to co-operate with those various temperance organizations which have for their object the suppression of this great evil. Especially would we recommend to your favorable consideration the recently organized "Canada Temperance Union." We are convinced that great good would be done the temperance cause if all our ministers would follow the suggestion of the Temperance Union, and organize Christian Total Abstinence Societies in

connection with all our congregations. Many of our people are ready to enter upon this work if our ministers will only take the lead. We would recommend the appointment of three of the members of this Conference as representatives to the next meeting of the Canada Temperance Union in September next.

REPORT OF COMMITTEE ON PRINTING.

Your Committee on Printing are desirous of giving an expression of the high estimation of the character, and the incalculable benefits of the weekly visits of the *C. C. Advocate*. And we observe that while our connexional paper maintains its character for usefulness, we are pleased to find that the net profits of the past year are considerably increased above the preceding year.

The liabilities of the concern are \$5,992.42, which very much cripples its prosperity. We are sorry to inform this Conference that the amount due to the Printing Establishment from the preachers of the three Conferences is \$1,873, of which there is a considerable sum against the preachers of this Conference. We would therefore earnestly solicit the members of this Conference, who are thus in debt, to settle with the Agent immediately.

Again, we observe in the Exhibit that there is the sum of \$343 47, including the interest, which some of the preachers hold either in claims or by notes of \$25 each against the establishment; and as a large majority of the preachers have relinquished such claims, we would therefore kindly request those who still hold such claims or notes to relinquish them likewise.

There is a large amount due from the subscribers, and an amount of \$1,000, supposed to be good, on the old accounts; we therefore recommend an immediate collection of them; and further recommend that each Presiding Elder at each Quarterly Meeting require of the preacher or preachers on our Circuits or Stations to give a strict representation of what has been done in *Advocate* matters during the quarter.

There is the sum of \$150 still unprovided for to complete the payment for the new Press: We therefore advise the preachers to solicit donations from our people so as to pay this amount as early as possible.

### REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION.

Your Committee on Education respectfully report as follows :

We devoutly acknowledge the goodness of God in the preservation of the lives and health of the Professors and students in our University and Ladies' College during another year. We feel highly gratified at the flattering success of these Institutions as presented in their annual exhibit, showing that there has been a steady increase in the attendance during each successive term the past year, and that the income from the students has exceeded the current expenses.

We congratulate our highly esteemed and efficient Agent, Rev. J. Wild, on his successful canvass in behalf of the University, and cordially pledge ourselves to still co-operate with him and the Board of Management in all proper efforts to free the University from debt, fill its halls with students, and secure for it a permanent endowment fund.

Your Committee notice a pleasing increase in the amount of the College collections; yet we believe that much more might have been obtained if all the brethren had brought the subject fully before the people, and taken up the collections at the proper time.

As it appears from the Exhibit of the Treasurer that several pressing claims demand almost immediate payment, we recommend that both the Presiding Elders and preachers in charge engage promptly in securing the collection of all old subscriptions, and centenary subscriptions not yet collected, and have the same forwarded to the Treasurer without delay.

Your Committee highly approve of the efforts of the ladies on the Colborne District, Ontario Conference, to raise a fund to aid in the education of candidates for our ministry; and we would recommend that similar efforts be suggested and encouraged in our Conference, either by the formation of District Associations, or by the ministers instructing and aiding enterprising women on their several charges in the matter.

## REPORT ON THE STATE OF THE CHURCH.

Your Committee on the State of the Church would respectfully report—

1st. That after a careful investigation of the progress made by the Methodist Episcopal Church in Canada within the bounds of the Niagara Annual Conference during former years, there is much cause for encouragement and devout thankfulness to Almighty God.

2nd. Our societies, although comparatively small, are generally prosperous, and our ministry and membership have a very considerable influence with the people of this Province.

3rd. Your Committee regret to state, however, that there is not as large an increase in the membership as might be expected from the number of laborers now employed in the Conference. This state of affairs should engage the serious attention of every member of this body.

4th. We account for this state of things principally from the fact that numerous removals of preachers and people to the United States are constantly going on, while we are not replenished by immigration as other bodies of the Dominion.

5th. We would not reflect on those who have honorably left us, but we think members of this Conference should carefully consider the wants of our connexion in this country, and that nothing but the most urgent necessity should induce them at this time to relinquish their relation with the Methodist Episcopal Church in Canada.

6th. We admit that there is a temptation to some of the preachers to remove to the neighboring Republic in consequence of the inadequate provision made by many of the charges for the support of the preacher and their families.

7th. In consequence of this state of affairs, your Committee would therefore recommend the Conference to appoint a Convention, to be held in each of the Districts within the bounds of this Conference, to take into consideration the state of the finances of the Church.

8th. The said Conventions to be composed of ministers and preachers travelling on each District, and three laymen or local preachers for each circuit, to be appointed by this Conference.

9th. Your Committee would recommend that the Conventions be held at the time and at the places hereinafter mentioned, viz: Niagara District Convention on June the 10th, 1869, to be held at Trinity Church, Brant Circuit; St. Clair District, June the 18th, 1869, Gosnell Church, Howard Circuit; Oxford District, June the 15th, 1869, to be held at Gore Church, Norwich Circuit; London District, June 22nd, 1869, to be held at Melroe.

10th. Your Committee are of opinion that our Mission work has been too exclusively confined to our outposts, and that we have not heretofore paid sufficient attention to our towns and cities. We hope, however, by our recent movements that after a time this will be obviated.

11th. In view of the desire manifested by the minor Methodist bodies in this Province for a more intimate relationship, we would recommend a Committee to be appointed by this Conference to correspond by letter or otherwise with the proper representatives of these or other bodies, and that a copy of this resolution be forwarded by the Secretary to the Ontario and Bay Quinte Conferences.
