

An Act to consolidate the debt of the Town of Peterborough, and to authorize the issue of Debentures on the security of Town property, and for other purposes.

HEREAS the Town of Peterborough has incurred debts and liabil- Preamble. ities amounting in all to the sum of eighty-six thousand four undred dollars, for the subscription of Stock to the Port Hope, Lindsay, and Beaverton Railway, for the erection of a School House, and for

- 5 other local improvements in the said Town; and is desirous of incurring further liabilities, to the extent of eighteen thousand two hundred dollars, for the completion of the purchase of land south of Townsend street, and cast of Park street, in the said Town, for the erection of an Engine House and Lock-up, and for the building of a new Town Hall; and the
- 10 Corporation have petitioned to have all the said debts and liabilities consolidated, and that Debentures may be issued by the said Corporation upon the security of the Town property, in order to raise funds for the liquidation of the said liabilities: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Can-
- 15 ada, enacts as follows:

I. The Town Hall, the Market Block, and the Land south of Towns- Certain Town end street, and east of Park street, with all the appurtenances thereunto property belonging, shall be, and the same are hereby declared to be vested in five Commission-Commissioners, to be held in fee simple upon the Trust hereinafter de- ers as 20 clared, and the said Trustees shall be called "The Commissioners of the Trustees. Peterborough Town Trust."

II. The said property shall be held by the said Commissioners exclu- Purposes of sively in Trust, out of the rents, dues, revenues and profits thereof to the said Trust. pay, in the first place, all reasonable expenses of managing the said 25 Trust, also all the necessary moneys that may be required to keep the said properties in good order, usefulness, and repair, and to insure the buildings against loss by fire, for such an amount as they, the said Commissioners, shall deem advisable; and secondly, to pay all interest moneys to become due on the Debentures hereinafter mentioned; and

30 thirdly, to establish a sinking fund for the payment of the principal debt.

III. It shall be lawful for said Commissioners to raise by way of loan Commissionupon the credit of the Debentures hereinafter mentioned, from any person or persons, body or bodies corporate, either in this Province or in Great Britain, or elsewhere, a sum of money not exceeding the sum of 35 one hundred and twenty thousand dollars.

IV. It shall be lawful for the Mayor and Town Council for the time Mayor and being, to cause to be issued Debentures under the seal of the said Cor- Town Council poration, to be signed by the Mayor, countersigned by the Treasurer of to issue

the said Town, and the Secretary of the said Commissioners, in such sums in sterling or current money, or part in one and part in the other, not exceeding in the whole the sum of one hundred and twenty thousand dollars, as the Town Council shall from time to time direct and appoint; and the principal, moneys and interest secured by the said Debentures 5 shall be made payable either in this Province, in Great Britain, or elsewhere, or part in one place and part in another, and at such times as the said Council shall deem expedient; and further the said Debentures shall on the face thereof respectively express that they are secured on the property aforesaid: Provided always, that the said Council shall 19 not issue any Debentures for the erection of a new Town Hall, until such time as a By-law providing for such erection shall have been passed by the said Council, having previously received the approval of the Ratepayers of the said Town, in the manner provided for the creation of Debts under the Upper Canada Municipal Corporations Act.

V. It shall be lawful for the said Commissioners either to exchange **Application** such Debentures for outstanding Debentures, or to pay the same to con-Debentures. tractors and others holding claims against the said Town, or to negotiate the same as aforesaid; and also to issue new Debentures if required from time to time, upon which to raise funds to retire those 20 which shall be outstanding; Provided that a larger amount than the Proviso. said sum of one hundred and twenty thousand dollars shall not be

at any time chargeable against the said Trust property.

VI. It shall be lawful for the Commissioners, and they are hereby required on or before the first day of July, in each and every year to 25 submit to the Corporation of the said Town of Peterborough, the amount required for the payment of the interest due upon Debentures issued under this Act, together with one per cent. for a sinking fund for the final payment, satisfaction and discharge thereof; and the Town Council shall thereupon impose a special rate equal to the amount so 30 required by the Commissioners, over and above, and in addition to all other rates to be levied in such year, and the money so collected shall be paid over by the said Corporation to the said Commissioners on or before the fourteenth day of December in each year; And any Treasurer, Collector, or other Municipal Officer or Functionary, or any Mem- 35 ber of the Municipal Council wilfully neglecting or refusing to perform or concur in performing any Official Act requisite for the Collection of the said rate, or misapplying or being a party to the misapplication of any portion of the proceeds thereof, shall be held guilty of a misdemeanor; and such Treasurer, Collector or other Municipal Officer, Member or 40 Functionary and his sureties shall moreover be personally liable for any sum which by reason of such neglect, misconduct, refusal or misapplication shall not be paid to the Commissioners at the time required by this Act.

VII. The following persons shall be the Commissioners of the said 45 Trust as soon as this Ast shall go into operation, that is to stay : Charles Bradfield, Samuel Dickson, James Stevenson, Edmund Chamberlen and William Hall,

In the event of the death, removal, absence or resignation of any of the said Commissioners, the vacancy or vacancies shall be filled 50 from time to time by the Town Council, who shall have power at any meeting specially called for that purpose, to appoint a new Commissioner in the room of any Commissioner so dying, removing, or absent-

ing himself from the Town, or resigning his office, and thereupon the said property shall yest in such new Commissioner along with the Commissioner or Commissioners who shall still retain office upon the same trusts as are heretofore declared.

- IX. It shall not be lawful for the said Corporation to incur any fur- Corporation 5 1X. manner as debts due by Municipalities under the existing laws.

The said Commissioners shall annually on or before the first day Annual Ac-20 of December, in each year, render an account to the Town Council of counts of Commissionall moneys received and expended. Also of all Debentures issued du- ers. ring the year, as well as of all outstanding; and the books containing the transactions of the Company shall be open for the inspection of the 25 rate-payers of the said Town at all reasonable hours.
