AT LEAST IT IS ANNOUNCED THAT HE WILL BE TO-DAY.

LONDON, July 21.—Mr. Gladstone at two o'clock this afternoon received from the Queen her Majesty's command to resign the office of Premier and his ministers. As soon as his messenger returned Mr. Gladstone notified his colleagues. He will not proceed to London to personally surrender the seals of office until Her Majesty shall have appointed his successors.

It is officially announced that the Queen summoned the Marquis of Salisbury to form a Ministry on Thursday morning.
