JAMES YOUNG OF C.U. Canadians Ready for Free Trade, but not for the Free... The following is from a letter written by Mr. James Young of Galt to F. H. Thurber, chairman of a special committee of the New York Chamber of Commerce appointed to investigate C.U.

There exists almost universally throughout Canada not only the most friendly feeling towards the United States, but an ardent desire for free commercial relations between the two countries. Not that we cannot prosper otherwise. On the contrary, notwithstanding some serious mismanagement, Canada never developed so prosperously as she has since the twenty years since the Reciprocity Treaty expired. But our people have always recognized that both countries would be benefited by more freedom of trade and much improved trade relations.

While these views generally prevail, very strong objections exist to the settlement of the Commercial Union, proposed by Mr. Bristow of Ohio. His friends have held a number of meetings, mostly unopposed, which have passed resolutions in its favor. The condition being that the proposed union should not interfere with our relations with the great mass of Canadians, and they have so far given no general expression of their opinions upon it.

As far as I can judge the trend of public opinion, the principal features of Mr. Bristow's scheme, discrimination against British goods, pooling revenues with the United States and withdrawing our tariff and taxation from the control of our own representatives, would not be accepted by a majority of the people of Canada. It is a scheme which is not only inconsistent with the conditions of our trade relations with the United States, but also with our political and economic conditions.

There are no valid reasons, however, why a large and liberal measure of Free Trade should not be adopted between the United States and Canada without the national and political commitments of Mr. Bristow's scheme. The status of the two countries is quite equal to the preparation of a Commercial Union of the present type. The Fruit Growers and Mr. Blue. Editor World: It is quite true, as stated by Mr. Thos. Beall in his letter to you of Nov. 19, that the Fruit Growers' Association of Ontario is a non-political body, and that it is the earnest desire of its officers to avoid any discussion whatever on political questions. Commercial Union of course included. It is also true, as you say, that whenever the subject of political gatherings, rather than to one of the objects to be gathered and disseminated concerning fruit, flowers and forestry. You will recollect concerning Mr. Blue's paper. While it is true, as you state, that Mr. Blue of the Bureau of Statistics was invited by the Fruit Growers' Association to read a paper at the meeting, yet in his subject, any improper advantage, for he wrote asking whether a paper on "The Trade in Fruit and Fruit Trees Between Canada and the United States" would be acceptable. Hoping that the subject would be treated from a non-political standpoint, the paper was accepted. The title of the paper was given in the September number of your monthly journal, The Canadian Horticulturist, and that in no case can Mr. Blue be charged with taking the association as a disadvantage. I may add that the association as such does not purport to express any opinion, pro or con, on the subject of Commercial Union, leaving the whole question to be settled in those gatherings which have political questions as their proper subject of debate.

Editor World: In reply to Samuel McNab's of yesterday, I would like him to be more explicit. He says he has his doubts as to my right to sign my name. Does he mean by this that I am an coward in my actions on this matter and that he would lead the public to believe that our honorable society is compelled to follow in his footsteps on account of the prominence of his position among us? What had to say before concerning Samuel McNab I repeat. I can't understand why he, an advocate of labor, should advocate a man opposed to labor rights.

Editor World: Under our present laws only property owners are entitled to vote on bylaws to raise money for municipal purposes. Why do you or some advocate of the present system explain why this is so?
