An Act to amend chapter fifty-four of the Consolidated Statutes of Upper Canada, intituled "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada."

**WHEREAS** it is necessary to amend the two hundred and seventy-ninth Section of An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada; Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:—

- 1.** Whenever it is necessary to continue any ditch, constructed under the provisions of the said two hundred and seventy-ninth section beyond the limits of the Township, the Council of such Township shall serve a written notice upon the head of the Municipality within which such ditch is to be continued, stating that the ditch must be constructed by the Municipality upon which the notice is served, and also the point at which the ditch strikes the line between the Townships.
- 2.** The Council upon which the notice is served shall employ an Engineer to make plans and specifications of such ditch, and shall pass a By-law under the provisions of the said two hundred and seventy-ninth section, and shall complete the work within nine months from the date of the service of such notice.
- 3.** No By-law passed under the authority of the said two hundred and seventy-ninth section, shall be submitted to a vote of the rate-payers; nor shall such By-law be altered or repealed until the purposes for which it is passed shall have been satisfied.
