CANDAMAR DISASTER.

It is stated that arrangements have been made to despatch a detachment of 4,000 men from England to Afghanistan from England within a few days. The military authorities are prepared to supply 12,000 troops of all arms, and the Admiralty has signified to the War Department its readiness to provide transportation for 20,000 men within three weeks.
