A Lovely Country to Avoid.

A telegram from Fort Elliott, Texas, of January 28, says: "I estimated that there were 15,000 head of cattle dead on the prairie within a radius of 75 miles of this place. The prairie dogs are nearly all dead. Several persons were badly frozen. The lowest record by the mercury was 10 degrees below zero, and but if these 15,000 head of cattle had been on the ranching districts of the Canadian North West, they would not have been frozen."
