### **New Beauty** Fad in Paris.

Dr. Rosenthal Bleaches Teeth by Use of Ultra-Violet Rays.

Paris. Dec. 19 -The latest service rendered by science to the cause of feminine beauty is the discovery of Pierre Rosenthal of Paris that the ultra-violet rays of the spectrum. when directed on discolored teeth. bleach them to a dazzling whiteness.

The patient has to wear a mask of store linen, which leaves only the teeth and gums exposed to the light, and sits for about a quarter of an hour at a time in the rays of a very powerful mercury lamp, over which a quartz cover has been fitted, as well as the necessary cooling apparatus. To prevent any ill-effects, the teeth are kept moistened with oxygenized water during the operation.

It is the ultra-violet rays in the sunlight that bleaches such things as hen or ivory, says the doctor, and ne therefore makes his patients continue the treatment at home by sitting with their bare teeth to the sun-

A dry rubber "sponge" is excellent for cleaning woolen materials. They should be laid flat and the sponge swept over them briskly, care being


