



REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

FOR THE YEAR ENDING MAY 1ST, 1894.

Beyond the usual routine there has been no marked feature in the financial transactions of the year. Eight thousand and fifty dollars (\$8,050) were received during the year towards the reduction or the extinction of loans; twenty-eight (28) shares of the Merchants Bank of Canada were sold at \$156 per share, less brokerage, the net proceeds being \$4,361. The gross revenue from investments was \$8,317.36; a temporary loan was made for \$2,740; adding the balance from last year—\$4,207.38-- the total amount being \$27,675.74. The payments were, to the ministers as per Schedule C. in June and December, 1893, \$20,450; to Queen's College, Kingston, \$2,000; repayment of a temporary loan \$3,252.25, and for expenses of management \$627.93—leaving balance on hand \$1,345.56.

The cash value of investments and other assets in Schedule A. amount to \$136,969.31, being \$15,380.23 less than the valuation of this time last year, thus shewing the draft upon capital required to meet the expenditure.

The balance at credit of the special account with the commuting and privileged ministers is \$48,856.24, leaving \$88,113.07 to be dealt with in the interests of the non-privileged ministers.

CHANGES IN THE ROLL.—The names of three ministers have been removed from the Roll by death, namely, Rev. Joseph Eakin, some time minister of Parkhill, Ont., who

died at Toronto, September 8th, 1893; Rev. Duncan Morrison, D.D., a commuting minister, who died at Owen Sound on the 10th of January, 1894, in the 78th year of his age, and Rev. James Carmichael of Norwood, who died there on the 24th of April last, aged 64 years.
