An Act to amend the Act incorporating the Commissioners of the Port Hope Harbour, and to authorize them to borrow a further sum of money, for the completion thereof.

WHEREAS the Commissioners of the Port Hope Harbour, con-Preamble. stituted and incorporated under the provisions of the Act passed in the sixteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled " An Act 16 Vic. c. 140. to vest the Harbour of Port Hope and adjacent premises in Commis-5 sioners," have petitioned that the said Act and the Act therein and hereinaster mentioned may be amended in the manner hereinaster provided, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of their Petition: Be it therefore enacted, &c., as follows:

And for the avoidance of all doubts, be it declared and enacted. that nothing in the Act cited in the Preamble to this Act, or in any nave power to make By-laws other Act relating to the Port Hope Harbour, has affected or shall affect the right of the Town Council of the Town of Port Hope to make By. 20 laws for the regulation of the said Harbour, and of all persons and vessels using the same-and that it has been and shall be lawful for the said Town Council to make By-laws for the purposes aforesaid, and to Proviso: as to impose and enforce penalties for the contravention thereof, or to ratify, confirm and adopt as By-laws of the said Town Council any By-laws 25 lawfully made by the Commissioners of the Port Hope Harbour, and to impose and enforce penalties for the contravention thereof; provided that such penalties shall not in any case exceed those which the said Town Council is empowered to impose for the contravention of By-laws, by the Upper Canada Municipal Corporation Acts; and provided further that the 30 tolls to be taken upon goods shipped or landed at the said Harbour, shall be exclusively regulated by the said Commissioners, subject to the approval of the Governor in Council, as provided in the sixth section of the Act vesting the said Harbour in the said Commissioners, and cited in the Preamble to this Act.
