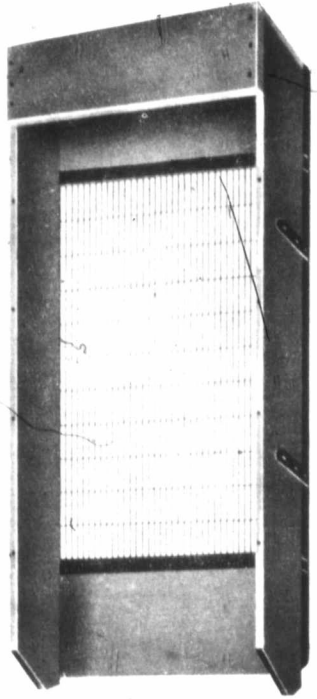

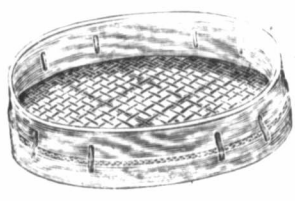

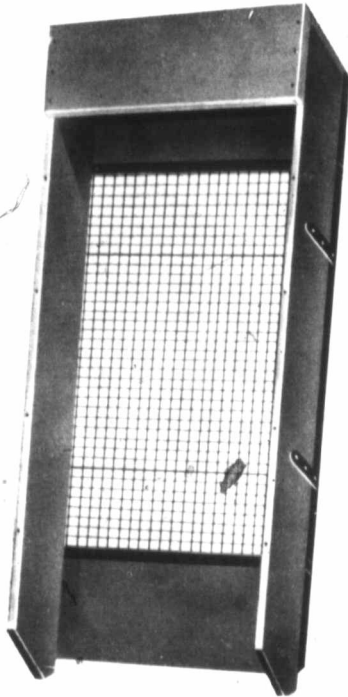

These Screens are made with a heavy wooden frame, strongly put together, and filled with extra heavy crimped hard steel wire. The screening is firmly attached to the frame, and secured with flat iron top and bottom, and cross rods are placed at the back of screen to prevent sagging when screening large heavy coal.
