FIRES

The stove mill at Castleford, Ont., owned by the Sutherland-Innes Company, of Chatham, Ont., was burned a few days ago.

A portable saw mill and about 500,000 feet of lumber belonging to J. I. Black & Sons, of Sackville, N.B., were burned at Aboushagan recently. The loss is about \$5,000.

CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS ONTARIO.

Reports from the Ottawa valley and Georgian Bay districts state that there has not been the usual mid-summer falling off in the demand for white pine, but that orders have continued to be placed in goodly volume. The activity in building in Ottawa and vicinity is chiefly accountable for the increased demand in that section, while the Georgian Bay mills are shipping largely to Michigan. There has been some scurrying around for dry cutting-up grades, which are in short supply. Sales of this stock are being made at Georgian Bay points at \$25, and stock boards at \$14 to \$16. Hemlock is very strong and brings from \$12 to \$14 at the mill, while there is good buying of all kinds of shingles. No. 1 cedars are held by manufacturers at \$2.50, and No. 2 cedar lath at \$2.00. No. 1 pine lath ranges from \$2.25 to \$2.50 at the mill. Hardwoods are held firmly, but have not materially improved in demand. Basswood is the exception and finds a buyer very readily. One manufacturer reports the sale of 50,000 feet, log run, at \$15.50. In Toronto trade is quiet. Some dealers state that prices are weaker and that purchases of lumber can be made at a reduction from the spring quotations. British Columbia red cedar shingles were recently advanced in price in Toronto, which advance has been sustained.

QUEBEC AND NEW BRUNSWICK.

The volume of building in Montreal this year has been small, and the retail demand for lumber necessarily limited. Export trade is also dull compared with this time last year, especially in spruce, and the opinion is expressed that the price of this lumber is likely to decline somewhat. Hardwood prices in Montreal are holding their own, but the demand is limited. Manufacturers of spruce in New Brunswick hope that the worst has now been passed, and that the market will improve in the fall. They recognize the necessity, however, of limiting their operations in the woods next winter. New Brunswick cedar shingles are very steady at \$2.90 for extras, on Boston rate of freight.

MANITOBA AND BRITISH COLUMBIA.

Dealers announce an encouraging improvement in the demand for lumber. Trade in Winnipeg has been brisk all season as a result of large building

operations. Permits have been issued this year for buildings aggregating in value nearly \$1,200,000. The immense grain crop is also a strong factor in the situation, and a very heavy demand for lumber is looked for in the fall. In British Columbia trade is fair and will be assisted by the improvement in Manitoba and the Territories.

The dealers in Winnipeg last week advanced the price of shingles 15 cents per thousand, and there is a prospect of another advance of 10 cents. They are scarce and in good demand.

UNITED STATES

There have been no signs during the past week that the white pine market of the United States was weakening. The demand from retailers throughout the corn belt where the drought has damaged the crops has fallen off, but this has been offset by an increased trade in the Eastern States. In the Lake Superior district the conditions are very favorable. There is activity in the demand for No. 4 boards, which have been sluggish for some time. Norway pine is likewise strong, with some grades bringing higher prices. Heavy shipments are being made to the east. Of twenty-three steamers which left Duluth last week loaded with lumber, sixteen were destined for Buffalo and Tonawanda. In the Saginaw valley white pine continues remarkably strong for this time of year, while hemlock is moving better than could be expected. From Cleveland comes the report that little Norway lumber has been received in the past two weeks, and there is a noticeable shortage of this in many sizes and lengths. There is still a shortage in the supply of good lumber held at Buffalo and Tonawanda, where prices have advanced slightly in sympathy with the strong position at the head of the lakes. Our Bay City and Saginaw price list this week shows a slight advance in the price of the thinner sizes of uppers, common, and shaky clear. The price of ash and birch at Buffalo has also been advanced about one dollar per thousand. Hardwoods generally are quiet, but steady. It is reported that elm is a trifle weaker. Eastern spruce is firm owing to the exceedingly limited supply rather than any buoyancy in demand. Clapboards are selling in Boston at \$30 to \$32 for extra spruce and \$28 to \$30 for clear. Shingles of all grades are strong. The supply of

white pine at Dulalo is so small that red cedars are getting the call.

GREAT BRITAIN.

The conditions in the British market are tending to confine operations to buying from stocks on hand. The importer is afraid to buy free-on-board at shipping points, fearing that prices may not yet have reached bottom. Russian shippers have made sharp reductions in their asking prices, but Swedish shippers have offered but slight reductions, while the Canadian exporter has refused almost emphatically to yield to the demands of importers for lower prices. It is generally believed that the time has now come when confidence will be restored to the timber trade, and that it is in the interest of shippers to hold their stocks for a while. It is significant that during the past year of depression very few financial embarrassments have occurred. The docks at London are now blocked with timber cargoes, but, as practically no midsummer buying was done, this situation will soon be relieved. Reports tell of a more hopeful outlook for pine than for spruce, which is showing weakness. A cargo of spruce deals and boards, from St. John, N.B., was sold at Liverpool, on July 12th, the deals realizing £5 10s per standard for fourth quality, unassorted ends £5 12s 6d, and inch boards £5 2s 6d. While at London and Liverpool spruce is weak, we hear that 3x9 and 11 inch spruce is stiffening in price at Manchester. In another column will be found the prices obtained for pine and spruce deals at a sale held in Hull.

STOCKS AND PRICES

The steamer Daventry is loading a cargo of timber and deals at Quebec for W. & J. Sharples.

The str. Wanderer is loading lumber at the Hastings Mill, Vancouver, B.C., for Sydney, Aus.

The steamer Dunmoor Head is loading a cargo of lumber at Montreal for Cork, and will sail this week.

The biggest raft of logs ever towed on Lake Superior reached Duluth last week. It contained about 8,000,000 feet and was towed 180 miles, making an average of one mile per hour.

The steamer Tectonia is loading grain, asbestos and lumber at Montreal, for Hamburg. The barque Bellas is loading deals at Chicoutimi, Que., for Lisbon, the cargo being supplied by Price Bros. & Co.

A dispatch from Bangor, Me., states that the past two weeks have been the dullest on record in any shipping season. The spruce mills are shut down, the old log supply having become exhausted and the new logs not having arrived on account of delays to drives.

It is announced that F. H. Clergue, of Sault Ste. Marie, Ont., has signed a contract with H. R. McLellan, of St. John, N.B., by which the latter has undertaken to cut and skid 300 cords of wood per day for two years. The wood is to be used for the purpose of making charcoal for the steel plant at Sault Ste. Marie.

In Chicago Norway piece stuff is scarce, with holders asking \$13, although some sales have been made at \$12.50. For 2x12, \$14.50 is asked. Good hemlock sells at \$9.25 to \$9.50. Cedar shingles have sold in cargoes at \$2.50 for 8-inch, and \$2.60 and up for 10-inch. The new list adopted by the Chicago dealers fixes the following quotations for lath in carload lots: White pine, \$3.75; mixed drv. \$3.25; No. 2, \$2.75.

We give below an extract from a communication received by a Montreal lumber dealer from a Chicago firm, describing the market in the Western States: "As regards the demand for timber, it is something beyond past history. Even during the World's Fair year the demand did not seem nearly as great, because it was then simply locally, but now it is all over the country; there is certainly

a great era of prosperity in the United States at the present time; prices are weekly advancing and we do not know where it is going to end. We sold considerable stock from our mills to go direct east, which is leaving us short here—so much so, that what stock we cannot get out ourselves, it seems impossible to buy."

The rates on lumber from Duluth, Menominee and the Georgian Bay district to Buffalo remain at \$1.50, \$1.87 and \$1.75 respectively.

The tonnage offering from Canadian ports is in excess of requirements, and lower rates are anticipated. Among recent fixtures are the following: "Chatfield," Quebec to Sunderland, 665 6d, timber, 800 stds, Halifax to W.C.B., 428 6d; 690 stds, Nouville to Mersey, 468 3d, 770 reg. Dalhousie to W.C.B. or B.C.I.,

458; 1,000 reg, Gaspé to W.C.B. or B.C.I., 428 6d; 800 reg, Halifax to W.C.B. or B.C.I., 428 6d; 900 reg, Dalhousie to W.C.B. or B.C.I., 528 6d.

THE BARBADOES MARKET.

Of the Barbadoes lumber market, Messrs S. P. Musson, Son & Company, say: The arrivals of white pine have been the "Jas. Daly," from Liverpool, N.S., on 11th, with 80 M shipping, 85 M second quality, which we placed by wire for Demerara at \$23 round. The "Alice" arrived from same port on 13th with 133 M shipping and 100 M second quality, which we sold by wire for Berbice at \$28 1-2 and \$23; and the "Minerva" from Jordan River, with 31 M shipping and 42 M second quality, which has been placed locally at \$24 and \$18. The market was strengthened considerably by the two previous cargoes being sent away and the purchaser being entirely bare, but as all the dealers now have some supply, a continuance of these prices cannot be looked for. In spruce there have been only two small receipts, 16 M by the "Leopold" from Paspébiac, Que., very nice quality, which we placed at \$17.56; and 54 M by the "Harry," which we sold at \$17.26 shipping, \$13.26 second quality—market is amply stocked for present requirements. Shingles—There have been several arrivals, all to our address. The "New Dominion," on 11th, from Campbellton, had 1,128 M laying cedar, and 50 M long Gaspé, which we sold at \$1.75 and \$3.60 respectively. The "Avance," from Paspébiac, Que., on 12th with 130 M split dimension, which we have sold at from \$3.80 to \$7.36 as to width; and 172 M sawn dimension, which fetched \$4.00 to \$3.60, and 34 M long Gaspé, which we placed at \$3.70. On following day the "Leopold" arrived from same port, with 400 M cedar laying for which we obtained \$1.75. 31 M long Gaspé \$3.70 and 120 M split dimension, which we sold at

\$3.20 to \$7.40, as to width. In spruce laying, the "Harry" brought 24 M to our address, sold at \$1.60.
