

BILL.

An Act to incorporate Trinity College.

THEREAS it has been represented to the Legisla- Preamble. ture of this Province, that divers inhabitants of the said Province have used their efforts to establish a College in connexion with the United Church of England and Ire-5 land, either in or near Toronto, or in such other place as may hereafter be determined on with the sanction of The Lord Bishop of Toronto, or in case of the division of the said Diocese, of the Bishops of any Dioceses into which the Diocese of Toronto may hereafter be divided, 10 under the style and title of Trinity College, and are engaged in erecting and establishing the same; And whereas it would tend greatly to advance and extend the usefulness of the said College, and to promote the purpose for which it was established, that it should be 15 incorporated; Be it therefore enacted, &c.

That there shall be, and there is hereby constituted and Corporation of Trinity Colestablished, at or near the City of Toronto or otherwise lego as aforesaid, a body politic and corporate under the name established. of Trinity College, which Corporation shall consist of,-20 Firstly, The Lord Bishop of Toronto, or in case of the Of whom to division of the said Diocese, then the Bishops of any Dioceses into which the Diocese of Toronto may hereafter be divided; Secondly, The Trustees of the said Trinity

College; and, Thirdly, the College Council of the said 25 Trinity College, not less than three in number, which said Trustees and the members of the said College Council shall be named in the first instance by the said Lord Bishop of Toronto, and shall in the event of their death, removal from the Province, dismissal from office, or resignation,

30 be replaced by other persons to be named in like manner, or in such other manner as may from time to time be directed by any Statute of the said College to be passed for that purpose, and so on continually for ever.

II. And be it enacted, That such Corporation shall have Corporate 35 perpetual succession, and may have a common seal, with powers. power to change, alter, break and renew the same, when and as often as they shall think proper; and the said Corporation may under the same name, contract and be contracted with, sue and be sued, implead and be im-40 pleaded, prosecute and be prosecuted, in all Courts and places whatsoever in this Province, and shall have full By-laws. power to make and establish such and so many rules,

the country or this Act) as they shall deem useful or necessary, as well concerning the system of education in as for the conduct and government of the said College, and of any other Institution or School connected with or dependent on the same, and of the Corporation thereof, 5 and for the superintendence, advantage and improvement of all the property, movable or immovable, belonging to, or which shall hereafter belong to the said Corporation; and shall have power to take, under any legal title whatsoever, and to hold for the said College, without any fur- 10 ther authority, license or letters of mortmain, all land and property movable and immovable which may hereafter be sold, ceded, exchanged, given, bequeathed or granted to the said Corporation, or to sell, alienate, convey, let or lease the same if need be; And the said Corporation shall 15 further have the right of appointing an Attorney or Attorneys, for the management of the affairs, and generally shall enjoy all the rights and privileges enjoyed by other bodies politic and corporate, recognized by the Legislature: Provided always, that no rule, order or regulation 20 which shall be made and established by the said Corporaby the Bishop tion in manner aforesaid, shall be of any force or effect until the same shall have been sanctioned and confirmed by the said Lord Bishop or Bishops as aforesaid.

III. And be it enacted, That all the property which shall 25 at any time belong to the said Corporation, as well as the revenues thereof, shall at all times be exclusively applied and appropriated to the advancement of education in the said College, and to no other object, Institution or Establishment whatever, unconnected with or independent 30 of the same.

Public Act

IV. And be it enacted, That this Act shall be considered a public Act, by all Judges, Justices of the Peace, and Officers of Justice, and by all other persons whomsoever, and shall be judicially taken notice of without being 35 specially pleaded.

Saving clause.

V. And be it enacted, That this Act shall not extend to weaken, diminish, or extinguish the rights and privileges of Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors, nor of any other person or persons, Body Politic or Corporate, ex- 40 cepting only such rights as are hereby expressly altered or extinguished.
