An Act to substitute Yearly Returns
for the Quarterly Returns required of
Clergymen and others, by the six-

WHEREAS it is unnecessary that the ^{Preamble.}
Returns hereinafter mentioned should
be made oftener than once in each year:
Be it therefore enacted, &c.
